employed repairing fore sail
Saw Grampases at 5 finished repairing
and bent foresail Middle moderate
breezes from S.W. Latter strong winds
from S.W.

Monday 24 Aug

First part strong winds
from S.W. to N.W. Middle fresh breeze
from W to W.S.W. Latter same

Tuesday 25 Aug

First part moderate
breezes from S.W. by W. Saw one
sail Middle same Latter calm

Lat 33° 27' N
Long 88° 31' W

Wednesday 26 Aug

First part very light
airs from the W. and calm
Middle and Latter light airs from
N. and N.E. one sail in sight

Lat 33° 30' N
Long 88° 58' W

Thursday 27 Aug

First part light
airs from the S. Middle and
Latter mostly calm one breeze in
sight

Lat 33° 30' N
Long 89° 40' W

Friday 28 Aug 1858

First part light breezes
from W. Middle and Latter light
variable airs and calms and sun
squally saw two sail Lat 34° 02' N
Long 89° 55' W

Saturday 29 Aug

First part light winds
from W.S.W. to N.W. Middle and
Latter calm two sail sight Lat 34° 19' N
Long 89° 44' W

Sunday 30 Aug

First part calm two sails
in sight Middle calm Latter light
breezes from W.S.W. ship steering close
several sail seen Lat 34° 20' N
Long 89° 45' W

Monday 31 Aug

First part light breezes
from W.S.W. to W.N.W. Middle and
Latter light airs from the Westward
and calms several sail in sight
Lat 35° 11' N
Long 89° 50' W

Tuesday 1 Sept

First part very light airs
from the Westward and calms Middle
and Latter same Lat 35° 11' N
Long 88° 40' W

Wednesday 2 Sept

First part fresh breezes from
W to W.S.W. at 5 P.M. lowered for sperm
whales and took one at 7 got him to ship
and hooked on at 11 got him in middle
and Latter strong breezes from the W
and rigger at 6 A.M. started the lines
at 11 A.M. lowered for whales thus ended
Lat 36° 50' N Long 88° 14' W
