

Schooner Cornelia

Monday 6 Sept 69 These 24 hours begin with strong gales from N.W. and fine weather steering S.E. & out of Hudson Strait at 8 P.M. passed the Battery Isles and Resolution Isles out into the Ocean once more middle and latter part moderate at 5 A.M. steered at N.E. by 4 along the land to Endeavour this day
Lat by obs 60.22 N Long by Chron 50.54 W

Tuesday 7 These 24 hours begin with light winds from the South and heavy heading to the N.W. middle part the same latter part with hails. the N.W. steering S.E. & all sail out the Gibbs in sight to Endeavour
Lat by obs 59.00 N Long by Chron 60.09 W

Wednesday 8 These 24 hours begin with light winds from N.W. and fine weather steering S.E. & with all sail out middle much the same at 6 A.M. calms at 10 A.M. light wind from S.E. sky overcast and every appearance of rain to Endeavour to obs

Thursday 9 These 24 hours begin and end with light winds from the Northward and calms steering S at 6 P.M. fresh wind from the Eastward with rain latter part calm saw a shoal of Black fish lowered but without success then a bump into a Bottle-nose Grampus and sunk him sky overcast to Endeavour to obs

Friday 10 These 24 hours begin with calms and a heavy swell from S.E. at 8 P.M. light wind springs up from the Westward middle and latter part fine breeze from the N.W. and fine weather steering S.E. & with all sail out to Endeavour
Lat by obs 53.40 N Long by Chron 53.36 W

Homeward Bound Sept 1869

Saturday Sept 11 All of these 24 hours fine winds from N.W. and N. with fine weather steering S.W. & sails employed at ships mast saw several Fin W. Hump Back Whales to Endeavour this day
Lat by obs 52.35 N Long by Chron 52.33 W

Sunday 12 These 24 hours begin and end with fresh winds from the East and N.E. with a sky overcast the sun out at intervals steering S.W. & with all sail out nothing in sight to Endeavour
Lat by obs 51.06 N Long by Chron 52.42 W

Monday 13 These 24 hours begin with fresh winds from the N.E. and fine weather steering S.W. & with all sail out middle part wind hails to N.W. at 6 A.M. steered S.W. & S.W. latter part wind hails to the Westward at 11 A.M. made the South head of Trinity Bay Newfoundland bearing N.W. 40 miles to Endeavour Lat by obs 48.33 N Long by Chron 51.54 W

Tuesday 14 These 24 hours begin with light winds from the Westward and fine weather heading S.W. middle part calm with a heavy swell heaving from the N.E. at dusk saw the light on the South Head of Trinity Bay at 6 A.M. light air from the South heading off shore at midnight tack to the West again wind freshening every appearance of a gale the land in sight to Endeavour
Lat by obs 48.02 N Long by Chron 52.00 W

Wednesday 15 These 24 hours begin and end with fresh winds from the Northward and squally middle part same latter part pleasant steering along the land to N.W. passed within 10 miles of St. Johns light saw several sails and one steamer to Endeavour this day Cape Race bearing N.W. dist 15 miles
