Friday Nov. 15th these day Calm in with fair weather took Lord these day we set main sail for the first time Scho on port tack with wind on water Steaming S. by East crew rigged up boats and making new flying jib pendant pumps attended to Vessel not leaking saw bad.

Saturday Nov. 16th all of the day Calm in with moderate Eastly wind Scho on port tack with main sail out and jib, crew employed in rigging the boats and other jobs around deck, pumps attended to.

Sunday Nov. 17th all of the day Calm in with calm and rain squally. Scho under short sail on port tack, saw Merchant Barkentine bound to Northward, no work. pumps attended to. saw ends this day.
