Monday Nov 18th first part comes in with light wind from the East, and Squally Weather Scho^r on port tack by the wind heading S. S. E. under short sails. Crew making new flying Gib pendant and foot ropes and repairing main try sail, pumps attended to, every 4 hours.

Lat 36.34 Long 39.05 West.

Tuesday Nov 19th all through these day comes in with light easterly wind. Scho^r on port tack under main sail and Gib heading S. S. East. crew employed on rigging up boats and other jobs. pumps attended to. Lat 29.00 Long 38.10.00 West.

Wednesday Nov 20th comes in with fresh breeze from the N. East. Scho^r on port tack under reef main sail and Gib. These day we brock out. Water Spring cask B&B 5 Barrel and start Barrel Park. Steaming S. East by East. pumps attended to, good look out kept and side lights out every night.

Lat 28.05 Long 36.40 West.

Thursday Nov 21st all through these day comes in with Moderate trades and clear Weather at noon we shak reef out main sail. Scho^r on port tack steering S. East. crew cleaning tools and making reef sails and some spare ariving, pumps attended to.

Lat 26.17 Long 34.27 West.

Friday Nov 22nd 1901. first middle and later part comes in with fine breeze from the Trade and clear Weather. Scho^r on port tack all sails set steering S. East. these day we rose off new main Jib top, algeard and clewline and sheet and new main pick down hol. crew cleaning tools and making cover for main sail, pumps attended to. some ends this day.

Lat 26.34.00 Long 32.13.00.

Saturday Nov 23rd 1901 first part of these day comes in with very light trades and clear Weather. small seas. we bent new flying Gib and rose off new algeards and sheets. Scho^r on port tack all sails out steering S. East. pumps attended to. Lat 25.37 Long 30.32 West.

Sunday Nov 24th first part of these day comes in with fresh breeze from the S. West and high seas. Scho^r on port Starboard tack under short sails heading S. East. later part still fresh S. West wind. pumps attended to. Lat 25.01 Long 29.10 West.

Monday Nov 25th all through these day sets in with S. West Gale and high seas running. Scho^r on Starboard tack heading S. E. under very short sail, fore throat algeard. S. Hook given way. we first and later fore sail again, pumps attended to every two hours.

Lat 24.40 Long 27.12 West.
