

Thursday Nov. 26th first and later part comes in with fresh breeze from the S.West and heavy sea Schooner on Starboard tack Steaming S.E. under main top sail fore and aft, crew making dust we made new mast coal for main mast and saddle on main boom, pumps attended to Brockout flour. Spung New Cask 5 Barrels.
Lat 23,40 Long 25,27

Wednesday Nov 27th comes in with light wind from S.West, and clear weather. Scho on Starboard tack under all sails Steaming S.E. East crew employed in repairing fore stay sail and other gabs, pumps attended to, Lat 22,30 Long 24,51

Thursday Nov 28th first part of these day comes in with light wind from North and clear weather Schooner on Starboard tack Steaming South, crew working on fore stay sail, pumps attended to.
Lat 21,00 Long 23,54 West

Friday Nov 29th all through these day comes in with light wind from the North, and clear weather Scho on port tack all sails set running off South saw two merchantman go in S.West and Steaming N.East, we finish repairing fore stay sail, Manuel de Burgo still off duty with bulo, pumps attended to.
Lat 19,42 Long 23,30^W saw ends there day 3

Saturday November 30th comes in with good weather light N.East trade Schooner on port tack Steaming South, in after noon spoke Mary & Simmons with 200 lb. then winter, pumps attended to, Lat 19,00 Long 22,10 West

Dec 1st Sunday, comes in with fine weather in morning we sighted Island of Sall at 3 P.M. came to anchor at Moravia Bay, all well and Board,

Monday Dec 2nd comes in with light wind from the trade we hoveup anchor and went down to port and anchor in after noon, we got timber to make barn for W. Boat, Scho: Carlota arrived in after noon

Tuesday Dec 3rd comes in with good weather moderate breeze from the trade at 10 A.M. we hoveup anchor and start for Brava cannot get away crew here, all well on board but Manuel Burgo, pumps attended to, Brockout Reef. Molasses and Brava

Wednesday Dec 4th comes in with strong breeze from the trade at 1 P.M. we came to anchor at Fuma Brava, in 15 fathoms of water and more the vessel, pumps attended to, part of crew went on shore to visit the folks.
