Dec 8, 9, 10, 11, 12-13, 14-15-16-17-18 Laying at Brava waiting for the mate. we discharge. Mate Manuel Jose Dunningo sick and Carlo Alfonso and Manuel de Burgo sick and Ship 6. Seaman and John Lima for mate

Dec 19th comes in with fine Weather we sail from Brava for Whaling with 18 men
 " 20 comes in with strong Trades Schooner undertrysail an 8th sighted to Antea
 " 21 comes in with strong breeze set undertrysail reef fore sail and fore stay sail pumps attended every four hours

Sunday Dec 22th all throw these day comes in with strong trade and foggy seas on Schooner on port tack under main trysail and fore sail and fore stay sail at sun down tack heading to northward pumps attended to
 Lat 18, 23 " Long 26, 30 West

Monday Dec 23th comes in with very strong trades and rough seas on Schooner on port tack standing in shore under short sail reef fore sail, no observations.

Tuesday Dec 24th comes in with very rough Weather schooner on Starboard tack under very short sail two reef fore sail, we saw Schooner Mary E Simmons at sun down wore round on port tack, pumps attended to
 Lat 18, 10 Long 26, 50 West

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Wednesday Dec 25, all throw these day comes in with strong trades and rough seas on Schooner on Starboard tack working to northward in company with Mary E Simmons at sun down wore round on port tack with very short sail pumps attended to
 Lat 17, 56 Long 26, 40 West

Thursday Dec 26th comes in with strong trade and rough seas on Vessel under short sail in company with Simmons these day we Brockport Beef, Pork, Rice, Molasses, on port tack at sun down wore round on Starboard, pumps attended to
 Lat 18, 30 Long 26, 31 West

Friday Dec 27th comes in with very strong trades and heavy seas running Schooner under main trysail reef fore sail and fore stay sail on Starboard tack at noon wore round on port tack in afternoon saw Simmons again, Weather been so rough that we cannot make cam
 Lat 18, 15 Long 16-15 West

Saturday Dec 28th comes in with more moderate Weather. Schooner on port tack under reef fore sail stay sail and trysail Simmons slowly in morning left Mandley came on board for little while and went back to his Vessel too rough to cam, at noon saw St Antoine on Weatherhome Schooner standing in shore pumps attended to
