Thursday Jan 16th These Day comes in with light wind from the trade and some sea on Scho on Port tack under main sail and head sails Boiling at 6 P.M. were rowed on Starboard tack outboard in side we pump out some fresh water 3 casks on main deck, pumps attended to at 7 P.M. Led Wartech no observations

Friday Jan 17th comes in with fresh breeze from the trades, Scho on Port tack Boiling and we put down some Oil, at 10.30 P.M. finished Boiling in after noon took in main sail set main try sail at 7 P.M. set Wartech pumps attended to.

Saturday Jan 18th comes in with very rough weather and rough sea on Scho on Port tack under main try sail fore sail and fore stay sail, roping on foot of Gib all gear at the point of Gib to be repaired, these day we finished put down the Oil, 35 Barrels pumps all under to no observations

Sunday January 19th comes in with strong breeze from the trade Vessel under short sails working to the windward pumps attended to no observations

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Monday Jan 20th comes in with strong trades and hazy afternoon, Scho under short sails working to the windward saw 2 merchant vessels going off S.W. West this day we repair our Gib both aback and around Hipp pumps attend to Lat 17.03 Long 26.07 West

Tuesday January 21th comes in with strong trades and blowy weather, Scho on Starboard tack under short sail working to windward saw merchant vessels going to S.W. West we bent Gib and Peta Lat 17.36 Long 26.45

Wednesday Jan 22th comes in with strong breeze and blowy weather Scho on Port tack under short sails, we sought fish and Papassey, these day we grind up horses shades and salt some fish pumps attended to Lat 17.03 Long 26.02

Thursday Jan 23th comes in with strong breeze and poor sea, Scho under short sails working to the windward on Starboard tack lots fish around, pumps attended to Lat 17.09 no Long

Friday Jan 24th comes in with strong breeze from the trade and cloudy weather Schooner under short sails working to the windward land in side pumps attended to no observations
