

Sunday Feb 16th Came in with strong trades and rough Schooner at S. Vincent for Howbar

Monday Feb 17th Came in with very rough seas and strong trades. Crew cleaning the vessel out and scrubbing copper

Tuesday Feb 18th at S. Vincent for Howbar. Crew scrubbing the copper

Wednesday Feb 19th at S. Vincent for Harbor

Thursday Feb 20th Sail from S. Vincent to Tarragal for Harbor. cannot get in. Calm under the land

Friday Feb 21st under Tarragal in calm. Vessel drifting in. There are two boats and two off shore. Three times spoke Mary C. Simmons.

Saturday Feb 22nd beat up to S. Vincent with strong breeze from the trade. Harbor W.P. Capt went on shore for water and sail on. Cruise hit to windward rest of day.

Sunday Feb 23rd Came in with fair weather moderate trades. Schooner under all sails working to the westward. in afternoon took in sail, pumps attended to

Lat 17 25 Long 25, 26 West

Sunday Feb 24th Came in with fine weather light trades and clear weather. Schooner put back on sails and standing. Schooner went by S. Vincent at sundown took in sail, pumps attended to, no observations, taking spoke. Dyer

Monday Feb 25th Came in with moderate weather and clear, all sails set standing to the eastward. Schooner A. Swift in side and land in side also, pumps attended to.

Tuesday Feb 26th Came in with moderate trades and clear weather. Schooner put back all sails set to land in side. Crew making oaken pumps attended to.

Lat 17, 00 Long 24, 10 West

Wednesday Feb 27th Came in with moderate trades and clear weather at noon came to anchor at Island of Salt to Hamphack. saw Hamphack off shore

Thursday Feb 28th Came in with strong trades, saw some Hamphack off shore, in hookshot. Butter molasses and corn, pumps attended to found that vessel leaking so we have to pump every two hours

Friday March 1st Came in with strong trades we sail for Mordena Bay to try Hamphack. saw some off shore, pumps attended to saw ends there day

Saturday March 2nd Came in with strong trades at anchor in Mordena Bay saw some whale off shore, pumps attended to every two hours
