Thursday April 10th Came in with strong breeze
crew employed in setting up rigging
sun in as this day

Friday April 11th Came in with good weather
we took on board recruits and some
Provisions

Saturday April 12th to anchor at Beano, all ready
for sea making for mail, 3 more
men, namely 1 Cook and two sea
men, kept trying to get some more
men in as this day

Sunday April 13th good weather no work
most of crew on shore, but an
officer in charge at all times in
port lots of vessels call for them
with passengers

Monday April 14th Came in with good weather
we shipped 4 more men two more
sun in as this day

Tuesday April 15th good weather mail steamer
arrived no letter for us today or
here,

Wednesday April 16th try to sail found a
strong all foul up with other
vessel in line of all the way
possible cannot leave any more
and back down into

Thursday April 17th came in with fine weather
we have to eat again and make
sail for Tarrafal to get water

Friday April 18th Came in with strong breeze ship under
short sails standing on wind on starboard
tack towards Tarrafal, pumps attended to

Saturday April 19th Came in with strong trades
ship on starboard tack under short
sails beating up to Tarrafal to get water
pumps attended to

Sunday April 20th Came in with strong breeze from
the trades in morning lighted St.
Antone's light beating up at sun down
close to Antone

Monday April 21th Came in with strong trades at
3 P.M. came to anchor at Tarrafal but
we have to tow in with three boats
kept sick with influenza been sick
ever since we left Beano

Tuesday April 22th we commence to get water

Wednesday April 23th finish getting water and made ready for
sea

Thursday April 24th took on board 30 Barrels of sweet potatoes
and some fruit

Friday April 25th with calm weather

Saturday April 26th in morning get under way
and turn out to sea with three boats
we shipped three more here 3 seamen
pumps attended to

Sunday April 27th Came in with moderate trades and
clear weather ship on starboard tack steering
N.W. by West all sails set all well on board
Lat 16, 56' Long 26, 17' West
