Wednesday May 21st Came in with light wind from South Sea under all sails biting to the windward in company with Simmons, at sun down took in sails.
 Lat 30.54 Long 49.45 West

Thursday May 22nd Came in with light wind from the South and clear weather, Schoon under all sails working to Westward with Simmons, in after noon spoke ship Glen of Genova, compare long with her. her long 50.44 West
 mine 50.38, 7 miles difference
 and saw Whaling Bark to the Westward of us, at sun down short in sails.

Friday May 23rd Came in with strong N.E. breeze and rough seas on Schoon under short sail on front tack in morning spoke morning boat Star, Simmons in side pumps attended to
 Lat 31.00 Long 50.53 West

Saturday May 24th Came in with light wind from the East and clear weather Schoon on Starboard tack working to Starboard in company with Simmons in after noon took in sails at sun down took in sails.
 Lat 31.10 Long 50.53 West

Sunday May 25th Came in with light wind from East, and clear weather, Schoon on Starboard tack with all sails set heading E.N.E. at noon saw White water trees on Weather Beam, we took ship but saw none of it in after noon saw Whaling Schoon to windward, and ~~Schoon~~ in side, at sun down took in sails.
 Lat 31.40 Long 50.04 West

Monday May 26th Came in with good breeze from East Schoon, under all sails biting to the windward in after noon spoke Bark Bertha and Pedro Varela and Simmons at sun down took in sails and were round on Starboard tack, pumps attended to.
 Lat 31.45 Long 49.34 W.

Thursday May 27th Came in with fresh breeze from East Schoon on front tack under short sails, in morning saw Pedro Varela, with few boats down chasing Whales, we lower our boats after we get to Pedro's Boat we made a haul with them at eleven o'clock there mate of Pedro struck
