Monday June 23rd Came in with moderate breeze from the N. East Schooner in Starboard tack under all sails steering N. West, crew employed in making seret, at sun down took in sails, pumps attended to

Thursday June 24th Came in with nice breeze from the South, Schooner under all sails steering N. N. West, at sun down took in sails and luff up to wind, pumps attended to

Wednesday June 25th Came in with good breeze from the South and clear weather Schooner under all sails steering N. N. West on port tack at 6, 30 P. M. Raised one large Whale on Weather Beam. to luff to lower. The Boat took in sails, pumps attended to
