Sunday August 24th Came in with fine weather light wind from the South and clear weather all sails set steaming W. N. West - we dropped water and beef, flour and small stores
Lat 34.58 Long 71-25 West

Monday August 25th Came in with light wind from the South and clear weather all sails set steaming W. N. West - in afternoon weather squally rain tender and lightning at 7:30 P.M. we took in main sail & topsail and flying jib all to suiting wind change with heavy squall tore jib and fore stay sail pumps attended to
Lat 35.04 Long 72-50 West

Tuesday August 26th Came in with moderate breeze from the Southeast we fix jib and fore stay sail and a bend in afternoon raised school of small Whales gang junk to S West saw that in edge of stream dead not lower boats, Lat 35.48 Long 73.47

Wednesday August 27th Came in with light wind from the N East all sails set on starboard took heading N West at sun down took in sails pumps attended to
Lat 36.14 Long 73.50

Thursday August 28th Came in with nice breeze from the N East in morning we raised school of small Whales struck 3, lost 2, and caught one. L B got dove took the whale along side at noon got gears up and cut whale and gear down and start fire at 6 P.M.
Lat 36.19 Long 73.58 West

Friday August 29th Came in with strong breeze from the N East and rough seas on finish boiling at noon. School in front back under short sails Lat 36.10 Long 74-19 W.

Saturday August 30th Came in with fine weather light wind from the N East we put all down and blow up decks at noon compare Long with steam barometer saw her Long 74.22
ours { 73.47 } (saw us out 3 1/2 to Eastward) { 0 35 }

Sunday August 31th Came in with light wind from the N East and clear weather, schooner under all sails cruising saw lots of vessels bound to the Northward, and plenty of porpoises, at sun down shorting sails
Lat 36.24 Long 74.20 West

Monday September first - Came in with very nice weather, light wind from the S West and clear weather, schooner under all sails sailing to S East. saw lots of porpoises and three and four masters, got N. Lat 36.40 Long 74.24
