Friday Nov. 14th Came in moderate breeze from East, and clear weather, all sails set on port tack heading S. E. by South crew employed on making mats for chafing gear and drying sails Haul ones and finished rigging up boats pumps attended to saw ends these days. Lat 33, 50 - Long 58 - 14 West,

Saturday Nov. 15th Came in with light wind from the E. S. East and clear weather, Schooner on port tack under all sails heading S. E. crew employed on fixing up the vessel and we set up flying jib, stays and some other gabs around decks, and pumps attended to Lat 32, 00 Long 57, 50 West -

Sunday Nov. 16th Came in with fresh breeze from the S. East and cloudy weather. Schooner on Starboard tack under all sails but flying jib and main top sail, in afternoon saw finbacks, pumps attended to Lat 32, 10 Long 57 00 West - Cook off duty sick.

Monday Nov. 17th Came in with very strong breeze from the East, and rough seas an Schooner under short sails on Starboard tack heading E. by N. pumps attended to Lat 32 - 08 Long 55 - 07 West -

Tuesday Nov. 18th Came in with moderate breeze from the South and clear weather all sails set on Starboard tack heading East - crew employed on making lunch hockout flour, bread, beans and Beef Rice Sugar and small stores, pumps attended to Lat 32 22 Long 52 45 West -

Wednesday Nov. 19th Came in with fresh breeze from the N. West Schooner on Starboard tack under low sails. Crew fixing up chafing gear Lat 32 - 10 Long 50 - 12 West -

Thursday Nov. 20th Came in with strong breeze from West Schooner under single reef sails heading off E. by South Lat 31 - 05 Long 48, 05 West -

Friday Nov. 21th Came in with strong breeze and Rainy weather wind N. West Schooner on port tack under two reef sails heading off E. S. East - Lat 31, 48 Long 45, 00 West -

Saturday Nov. 22th Came in with strong wind from the N. West and rough seas an Schooner on port tack under short sails heading off E. S. East, Captain sick Lat 32, 15 Long 41, 00 West -
