Lat 26-34 Long 27, 34

Sat, Dec 6<sup>th</sup> Came in with fresh breeze from the North and Clear Weather all sails set on port tack Steaming S. East, saw three merchant men standing to seaward crew scraping masts, pumps attended to, Capt Sick  
Lat 24, 15 Long 26, 29

Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> Came in with fresh breeze from the North and Clear Weather all sails set on port tack Steaming S. East crew scraping masts pumps attended to  
Lat 22 00 Long 26, 01

Monday Dec 8<sup>th</sup> Came in with moderate trades Schooner on port tack all sails set Steaming S. East, pumps attended to  
Lat 20 40 Long 26, 16

Thursday Dec 9<sup>th</sup> Came in with fresh trades schooner running off under all sails for St Vincent Capt very sick, Steaming S. by East pumps attended to  
Lat 17, 54 Long 26, 16

Thursday Dec 10<sup>th</sup> Came in with fresh trades all sails set on port tack Steaming S. by West at 5 P.M. sighted Island of Santa Antone schooner under short sails at Sun down, tack ship to Northward pumps attended to  
Lat 17, 14 Long 25, 48 West

Thursday Dec 11<sup>th</sup> Came in with strong trades schooner under reef under sail, biting to Weather Antone horned for St Vincent Capt Sick a little better, pumps attended to  
Lat 17, 25 Long 25-11, West

Friday Dec 12<sup>th</sup> Came in with strong breeze from the trade, and Clear Weather at 9 A.M. off St Vincent Capt went on shore to consult doctor, at 5 P.M. Capt came on board and we start off for cruise, pumps attended to

Sat Dec 13<sup>th</sup> Came in with fresh breeze from the trade schooner under short sails on Starboard tack St. Antone in sight pumps attended to  
Lat 17-32 Long 25, 58

Sunday Dec 14<sup>th</sup> Came in with very strong trades and rough sea on, schooner under two by sail and Lib on Starboard tack pumps attended to every 4 hours, Lat 18-43 Long 26, 17

Monday Dec 15<sup>th</sup> Came in with Calm wind from the trade in morning we hove round and Port tack under two by sail and Lib. Lat 18-00 Long 25, 49
