Thursday Jan 13th Came in with moderate breeze and clear weather. Schooner on port tack all sails set standing to the Eastward. Crew fixing up chafin' gear and pumps attended to. Lat 18.18 Long 25.32 West.

Wed. Jan 14th Came in with fine weather light wind from the trades. Schooner on port tack under all sails standing to the Eastward. We fix anchor stock and set on stanchions to fasten Marchpanser and clinning up rig gear, at Sun down took in sails. Lat 18.08 Long 23.50

Sunday Jan 18th Came in with strong breeze and rainy and squally weather in morning. Schooner on port tack steaming off South at 3 P.M. were around on starboard tack steaming W & West. Saw steamer going S.W. in afternoon more moderate and clear weather. Lat 18.40 Long 24.05 West.

Monday Jan 19th Came in with strong trade and squally weather and rain. Schooner under short sails running off steaming off N West at noon. Hove to on wind in hookout water. Start cask of Sugar and cask of Beef and start barrel of Pork, blackant Sugar molasses Rice Beans and Peas at 5 P.M. moved on port tack. pumps attended to. Lat 18.48 Long 25.58 West.

Thursday Jan 20th Came in with fresh trades and rough seas on schooner under short sails, biting to the windward. at Sun down took in fore sail set fore trysail pumps attended to. Lat 18.26 Long 25.07

Thursday Jan 21th Came in with fresh trades and cloudy weather. Schooner on port tack under very short sails in afternoon passed steamer going S.W. - all well on board crew making knots. Lat 17.32 Long 24.47

Thursday Jan 22th Came in with strong trades and rough seas on at 9 A.M. were rounded on starboard tack heading N. & East - Schooner under trysail fore sail and Gib three day Antonio J. Luis Silva despatched order and refuse duty. and he was put in irons for drinking rum and for drawing cloth on Captain and he said that he don't care for no body, this is third time that he comes shoble on board but this is first time that he was punished at Sun down took in fore sail set fore trysail, crew making knots low endy this day. Lat 17.21 Long 24.18 West.

Friday Jan 23th Came in with fresh trades and cloudy weather. Schooner under short sails working off to the leeward saw merchantman going S.W. - at noon cook came to his duty again, crew making knots and other jobs, at Sun down took in fore pumps attended to. Lat 17.41 Long 25.07 West.
