

Sunday Feb 8th Came in with fresh trades and cloudy weather. Schooner under short sail working to the windward, in company with Joseph Manta, at Sun down took in fore sail set fore trysail pumps attended to
Lat 17.28 Long 26.50 West

Monday Feb 9th Came in with moderate trades and Hazy weather. Schooner under all sails tacking to the windward in company with Manta, we set up main topmast and other jobs we rose off main boom tacked fore, at Sun down shorting in sails
Lat 18.20 Long 26.51 West

Tuesday Feb 10th Came in with light trades and smooth sea, all sails set standing on wind on Port tack, in company with Joseph Manta, crew making Suet
Lat 18.32 Long 26.02

Wed Feb 11th Came in with very fine weather and clear, Schooner under all sails working to the windward Manta in side at Sun down took in sails crew making Suet pumps attended to
Lat 18.32 Long 26.02

Thursday Feb 12th Came in with light trades and clear weather, Schooner under all sails coming, Manta in side at Sun down shorting sails crew making Suet
Lat 18.50 Long 26.25

Friday Feb 13th Came in with very fine weather and clear, Schooner under all sails coming in the morning at 3.30 AM. Raised a school of small whales. Lower two boats L.B. struck. L.B. struck also and got stove and cut line, L.B. brought her whale along side and went off a and struck L.P. whale and killed her and brought to ship took whale along side at 4 PM took in sails
Lat 18.50 Long 26.30

Saturday Feb 14th Came in with fine weather and clear, at 7 in morning we commence to cut in at 1 P.M. finished took gear down and commence to clear up the heads at 4 P.M. start fire, at Sun set took in main sail set main trysail Schooner on port tack, pumps attended to
Lat 18.50 Long 26.40 West

Sunday Feb 15th Came in with fresh breeze from the trade, Schooner on port tack under short sails Boiling and we pump out some water getting casks ready to put some oil, we caught some fish, pumps attended to
Lat 18.30 Long 26.25

Monday Feb 16th Came in with fresh trades and clear weather, in morning we were rowed on on Starboard tack at 7 clock finished Boiling we put oil down and down Suet casks away all finished at Sun down Whales made 40 barrels of oil pumps attended to
Lat 18.40 Long 26.30
