Thursday Feb 19th Came in with light wind and rain squally in morning we set for sails, Schooner on port tack working to the windward, Capt. working on S. Boat, crew making senet.

Friday Feb 20th Came in with nasty weather squally and rainy, Schooner on Starboard tack standing on wind under short sails, Capt. working on S. Boat, crew making oaham and senet, pumps attended to.

Lat 18-37 Long 26-41

Sat. Feb 21st Came in with strong breezer from the S. East and squally weather in morning we were rowed on Starboard tack, and set fore sails and flying Sub. at 11 A.M. Raised lots of White Water Head Skips to be shot of small Whales going to the windward then went out of side.

Lat 18-34 Long 26-30

Monday Feb 22nd Came in with strong breezer from the trades and rough seas on the under short sails working to the windward at sun down took in fore sails at fore try sail and pumps attended to.

Lat 18-40 Long 26-15-

Tuesday Feb 23rd Came in with strong trades and foggy weather and rough seas on schooner under short sails on Starboard tack at noon Raised School of Small Whales close to the vessel going to the windward their got to the windward of ship we did not lower Boats we set fore sail and beat after them saw none of them at sun set took in fore sails set fore try sail.

Lat 18-43 Long 26-15-

Wednesday Feb 24th Came in with very strong trades and rough, Schooner under short sails beating to the windward saw nothing at sun down took in fore sails set main try sail, Capt. finished repairing S. Boat at 4 P.M. we put her out on cranes and rigged up ready for business, breackout molasses, pumps attended to.

Lat 18-44 Long 26-03.

Wed. Feb 25th Came in with strong trades and rough seas on, Schooner under short sails on Starboard tack, at noon were rowed on port tack, we breackout Pork, pumps attended to.

Lat 18-45 Long 26-57 West
