

Saturday March 7th Came in with moderate trades and clear Weather, Schooner under short sails working to the leeward, at sun down hove to on port tack, all well on board 2nd mate came to his duty, pumps attended to Lat 18-26 Long 26,50 West

Sunday March 8th Came in with fresh trades and blowy Weather, in morning we wore round on starboard tack, under short sail at 11 A.M. set fore ^{fore sail} ~~fore sail~~ vessel heading North at noon saw merchantman to the windward going West, pumps attended to Lat 18,20 Long 26,32 West

Monday March 9th Came in with moderate trades and clear Weather Schooner under short sails cruising at sun down took in early, pumps attended to Lat 18-44 Long 26,46

Tuesday March 10th Came in with good Weather moderate trades and clear Weather, set on starboard tack under all sails but main sail, working to the windward at noon were round on port tack we bent Flying Jib and clean lower spade, pumps attended to, Lat 18,49 Long 26,25

Wednesday March 11th Came in with nice Weather in morning we made all sails Schooner on wind on starboard tack at noon hept off W. N. West - at 1.30 P.M. Raised school of small Whales lowered boats, L.B. and S.B. caught one Whale a free took Whales along side at dark S. 78,54 E. 25,53

Thursday March 12th Came in with fine Weather at 7 o'clock in morning we commence cutting in at 2 P.M. finished got gears down and blew away the heads, at midnight start fire, no observation then day at 3 P.M. took ship at sun down short in early, brockport barrel of flour,

Friday March 13th Came in with strong trades and rough seas on, Schooner on port tack under very short sails Boiling and we put some oil down, and pumps attended to Lat 18,21 Long 26,11 West

Saturday March 14th Came in with very rough Weather, Schooner on port tack still Boiling and we put some oil down at 6 P.M. finished Boiling in afternoon more moderate Lat 17,40 Long 25,30 West

Sunday March 15th Came in with strong breeze from the trades, and heavy seas running, Schooner under short sails on port tack stowing down oil, at noon in side at 8 A.M. we hept off for Brava at 4 P.M. finished stowing down oil and wash of the vessel pumps attended to

Monday March 16th Came in with, very strong breeze from the trades and rough seas on at 9 A.M. came to anchor at Brava to send oil home found here lots of vessel we moved the vessel and washed of our side and pumps attended to
