 waiting for the mail crew on shore
 on Warch on liberty
 Saturday April 17th one Warch on liberty
 we took on board Rice Bedon and
 crew
 Sunday April 18th at Brava
 waiting for the mail
 Monday April 19th 20th at Brava,
 we try to get airt but was no wind
 fitting to sail
 Tuesday April 21th we have up anchor and
 run to line on Ponta Badgo to make
 sails; small cutter runs has some
 and some some demage on
 sea & gears we have to stop to
 fix, can't get out

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Wednesday April 22, at 730 A.M. we sail
 from Brava to Farrafal for Water, wind
 light and clear Weather Steward
steering Boat this season
 Thursday April 23, comes in with very light
 wind in morning, in afternoon
 calm. Antonio and St Vincent in
 side, we wash her off and
 put few new stop on main stop
 to chel and after labor around
 her ends this day
 pumps attended to
 Friday April 24 comes in with fresh breeze at
 430 P.M. came to anchor at Farrafal more
 to Trigo to get Water, pumps attended to
 Saturday April 25 at anchor at Farrafal we commence
 to take Water on board
 Sunday at Farrafal no work April 26
 Monday April 27 at Farrafal taking Water on board
 Tuesday April 28 at " " " " " " " " " " " "
 Wednesday April 29 at " " " " " " " " " " " "
 and show off the hole at 5 P.M. we got throw
 on vessel ready for sea,
 Thursday April 30, in morning we sail from Farrafal for
 St Vincent at 8.30 P.M. we came to anchor
 at St Vincent, pumps attended to some
 ends this day
 Friday April May 1st at St Vincent we took on board
 some Botatou sugar onions and other small
 stores and fix pumps
 Saturday May 2nd at St Vincent
 we discharge one mane George Hamilton
 and we ship mother one
 some ends this day.
