Friday May 15th ^{the} came in with fine weather very light wind from the South. we finished boiling and put some oil down, pumps attended to

Saturday May 16th came in with light wind from the S West. Schooner under all sails running off. Stearing N.W. by North. we finished stowing some oil and wash tank off, pumps attended to, no observations being cutting blocks.

Sunday May 17th came in with moderate breeze from S West and clear weather all sails set. Stearing off N.W. by North, pump attended to, no sight was taken.

Monday May 18th came in with light wind from the West and cloudy weather and rain squalls. Schooner under all sails Stearing off N.W. West we gained up heads and other jobs around.

Lat 22.40 Long 42.90 West. Raised school of small Whales going N.E. and we later boats but it was too late. we stand no chance to get any of them. Lat 28-53 Long 46-48 West.

Tuesday May 19th came in with moderate breeze from the S West, and clear weather. in morning we Raised 4 young Bow Whales going S West we lower two boats and chase. Whales went to the windward, but finally S.B. had chance on them and went on. just got wrapping reach Whales went. Boat started on S.W. just got fast for moment, and the river came out than Whales went to the windward quick and boat came in for

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Wednesday May 20th came in with light wind from the S West and clear weather, Schooner under all sails on Port tack Stearing off N.W. West. crew grinding shades and other jobs around, at noon time we Raised large school of small Whales. we dropped the boats. S.B. struck and S.B. struck and their kill. three more Whales. Ship picked up 2. and boats brought tree to the vessel soon we got 5 Whales struck land. we took last Whale along side at 6 P.M. we hoisted boats up and got gears up before night, at 7. we got supper and set watch, no observations this day.

Lat 27.25 Long 47-42 West. Thursday May 21th came in with fresh breeze from S West at 5.30 in morning we commence to cut in, at 1 P.M. finished, cutting in got gears down and start clearing way the heath, at 6 P.M. got supper and set watch, and start fire pumps attended to, no observations.

Friday May 22th came in with quite breeze from S West, and rain squalls at times. Schooner in morning we took in main sail set main by sail Schooner on Port tack Boiling and we pump some casks some job ready for to put down oil no observations.

Saturday May 23th came in with moderate breeze from the S West, and rain squalls at times. Schooner under short sails Boiling at 5 P.M. we finished boiling and we put some oil down. Broke out bag of Flour and some cask of Bread. pumps attended to. Lat 30.02 Long 47.27 West.
