Thursday June 4th Came in with calm Weather and heavy Swells and rain Schooner under short sails all day, crew making oakum and other jobs, Brockport Flour, pumps attended to, saw ends this day

Friday June 5th Came in with very nasty Weather, fair wind from NEast under and light rain and rain frequently Schooner under short sail and starboard tack all day, w. Brockport Flour, and pumps attended to, Lat 31.25 Long 49.05

Saturday June 6th Came in with light Easly wind and clear Weather in morning made all sails and run her off S. West - at 7.40 A.M. saw Bark Platina spoke her in after noon, she ad 50. Barre cense sail from Danimca, at sun down took in sails

Lat 31.22 Long 49.30 West

Sunday June 7th Came in with moderate breeze from the NEast and clear Weather in morning made sails and run off to the Westward in company with Bark Platina, at sun down took in sails and hove to on starboard tack pumps attended to

Lat 31.17 Long 49.47 West

Monday June 8th Came in with moderate breeze from the NEast and clear Weather, all sails set running West all day with Platina saw no think at sun down took in sails and hove to on starboard tack, crew making oakum and other jobs, at sun down took in sails and hove to on starboard tack

Tuesday June 9th Came in with light wind from the NE, and clear Weather, Schooner under all sails fitting to the windward in company with Bark Platina at 6.30 P.M. Raised alone Whale going S.W. was to bait to lower boats, at sun set took in sails Lat 31.36 Long 51.44 West

June 10th Came in with fine Weather, nice breeze from NEast and clear Weather, Schooner under all sails fitting to the windward in after noon spoke Platina, at sun down took in sails and pumps attended to, Lat 31.37 Long 52.27 W. saw ends this day

Tuesday June 11th Came in with moderate wind from NE, and clear Weather, Schooner under all sails. Standing to the Eastward with Bark Platina at noon we Raised alone Whale going S.W. we lower two boats and chase. L.B. went on the the Whale, just as the boat got to the Whale small boat steamer dart his runs on Whale small dead not wait to get forward enough and the Whale was stare showing very good chance if boat steamer waited a ways than for dead not get fast, it was worst than mist, boats chase all rest of day but cannot get to the Whale any more, at sun set boats came board and we took in sails and lay back all night Lat 31.40 Long 52.40 West

Friday June 12th Came in with calm Weather no sails set all day. heavy Swells from the NEast and clear Weather. Brockport small small stores, pumps attended to Lat 31.10 Long 52.56

Saw Boat had large Whale mist
