Saturday June 13th Came in with light wind from the N East and clear Weather. Schooner on Port tack all sails set standing on wind at noon Raised School of Small Whales way to the windward lower boats and pulled up there but Whales was going quick to the windward, boats could not get to them at sun down boat came on board. then we shorting sails
Lat 31.10 Long 51.57. West

Sunday June 14th Came in with calm Weather and swell. and clear atmosphere Schooner under short sails all day. pumps attended to, Lat 31.22 Long 52.02, W.

Monday June 15th Came in with moderate breeze from S.W. and clear Weather in morning we made all sails and run off N East at noon we gived ship Steaming N. West at 4 P.M. gib again on Starboard tack and took in main sails and flying Jib. breeze increasing and rain at sun down hove to, and took in fore sail and Jib pumps attended to, Lat 31.35 Long 51.50 W

Tuesday June 16th Came in with nasty Weather blow and rainy Weather all day Schooner under short sails on port tack all day heading N. West, pumps attended to. saw ends there day Lat 31.46 Long 52.05 W

Wednesday June 17th Came in with strong S West breeze and rain and squaw Weather. Schooner under short sails running to the North at sun set took in fore sail and Jib
Lat 32.53 Long 50.50

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Thursday June 18th Came in with strong S West breeze and rough seas on Schooner under short sails on port tack all day under short sails at sun set took in Jib. pumps attended to
Brockport Beef and Flour
Lat 33.29 Long 51.04 West

Friday June 19th Came in with good breeze from West and clear Weather in morning we made all sails, on starboard tack heading S. S. W. all day we saw black fish, at sun down shorting sails
Lat 33.00 Long 51.12 West

Saturday June 20th Came in with moderate breeze from the West and clear Weather Schooner under all sails on starboard tack heading S. S. West in after noon spoke Pedro Varela at sun set took in sails
Lat 31.50 Long 51.03 West

Sunday June 21th Came in with light wind from West and clear Weather in morning we Raised large lone Whale going quick to the windward we lower boats with Pedro Varela mated chase the Whale and side of the ship cannot get to him, at 1 P.M. boats come on board we beat rest of day saw none of it at sun down took in sails Lat 31.50 Long 51.22,

Monday June 22th Came in with with light wind from the S. West and rain about all day Schooner under short sails working to the windward, Pedro Varela in howr campy at sun set took in fore sail and Jib, pumps attended to
