Thursday June 23rd Bames in with moderate wind from the S. West and rainy Weather Schooner under short sails cruising in company with Pedro Varela, Crew making Oatmeal and Blenny heads, pumps attended to

Lat 31,30 Long 51,40 W

Wes June 24th Bames in with light wind from the West, and rainy Weather Schooner under short sails standing to the Northward Pedro Varela in sight we Brock out small stores, no Observations

Thursday June 25th Bames in with strong Westly wind and rough seas on Schooner under short sails standing to the Northward at Sun down took in Sails,
Lat 32,10 Long 51,56

Friday June 26th Bames in with nasty and rainy Weather and Variable wind, all the day, Schooner under short sails standing to the Northward, pumps attended to

Lat 32,34 Long 51,59

Saturday June 27th Bames in with squally Weather and rain all day, Schooner under short sails heading East in afternoon saw Whaling Bark off bow, at Sun down short in sails, no Observations

Sat June 28th Bames in with calm Weather all of day in afternoon spoke Bark Canton, with 300 Barrel of oil, saw ends this day

Lat 33,48 Long 51,25

June 29th Bames in with light wind from the S. West. Schooner under all sails steaming S. East at 6 P.M. Raised school of small Whales toward boat. L.B. Stuck and J Boat Stuck and got stove up badly but we caught both Whales. J Boat took stowing Boats Whale, at 8 P.M. took last Whale along side. took boats up and shorting sails

Lat 33,32 Long 50,44 W

Thursday June 30th Bames in with light S. West wind, in morning we start cutting in, finished at 9.30 took gear down and blew away the heads at Sun down took main sail and start boiling spoke B Canton Lat 33,50 Long 50,28

Wednesday July 1st Bames in with light wind from the S. West and clear Weather, at 4 P.M. finished boiling, and Raised school of small Whales in morning we lower boats made with B Canton we caught 6 Whales. J Boat took 3. we took three along side, L.B. lost one Whale, Lat 33,31 Long 50,15

Thursday July 2nd the Bames in with light wind from the S. West and clear Weather, in morning we commenced to cut in at 1 P.M. we finished took gear down, and blew away the heads at 5 P.M. start fire no Observations Bark Canton in side, pumps attended to, saw ends this day
