Friday July 3rd came in with light wind from West and clear Weather. Schooner under short sail, Boiling. Canton also Boiling this day we pump out some fresh Water and put down some oil, one man was put in view by been to Sadey and he was let out after 2 hours latter Lat 34,00 Long 50,10 West

Saturday July 4th came in with fresh breeze from the S. West - still Boiling, at 10 A.M. we Raised large lone Whale going to the windward we lower 1 Boat and Canton 4 Boats her fourth mate struck him we got the Whale made it was 100 Barrels Whale. Barck Canton took the Whale along. side we took the Body and mated in.

Sunday July 5th came in with strong breeze from the West, we cut in the Body and start fire at 7 P.M. Canton with his. we burnt Boiling, no observations

Monday July 6th came in with fresh breeze from the West, and clear Weather, Both vessels on start on back Boiling, we spoke Allen A. Swift

Thursday 7th July came in with light wind from the West. Schooner under short sail Boiling in after noon we caught little calf. he was all lone. in after later we saw large Whale going S. West. Canton and Swift and 2 lower boats but caught none we cut in little calf. no observation

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Wednesday July 8th came in with light wind from the West and clear Weather in morning we began up the oil with Barck Canton wash in been mated in his fair of oil. Canton had 88 Barrels we 84. saw there as 2 Barrels of oil as has on board of Canton to be taking when we got in port. or before if possible

Thursday 9th came in with nasty Weather squally we finished putting down oil and spoke Brile and little calf and we spoke Swift, Canton went out side this day. Steward off duty sick

Friday 10 July 10th came in with nasty Weather and rough Schooner under short sail, Steaming S. East Crew washing the vessel in side in after noon Raised Whales going S. West caught not lower boats Weather very rough

Saturday July 11th came in with strong breeze from the S. West and squally Weather spoke Pedro Farcha, in afternoon Raised three Pool Whales mate of Pedro struck one and lost him iron drowed saw we caught none at San don took up Boats, Steward off duty
