Sunday July 12th Came in with moderate breeze from the S. West schooner under all sails, crewing in company with P. Varela. Lat Sun 33° 00' Long 47° 04'

Monday July 13th Came in with light wind from the West and smooth sea. Schooner under all sails, crewing with Pedro Varela. Crew making oaroom and we fix up cutting gear. pumps attended to. Lat 33° 02' Long 47° 29'

Tuesday July 14th Came in with light wind from the S. West and clear weather. we Raised large alone Whale lower two boats to Boat Hatch we took the Whale along side at noon. we have made with Pedro Varela in afternoon we start to cut in at 5 P.M. Pedro took the Head and we cut the body and start fire Steward of duty. Lat 32° 55' Long 47° 29'

Wed July 15th Came in with very light wind from the S. West and clear weather. we have boiling and Pedro Varela also. no observations this day.

Thursday July 16th Came in with light wind from the S. West and clear weather. Boiling, we Raised large lone Whale, lower two boats and Pedro took the Whale along side. Lat 32° 50' Long 47° 35'

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Friday July 17th Came in with fine weather. we cut in the Whale. Pedro Varela took the head and we took body at 4 P.M. took Gears Sawn and Star fire again. no seals taking.

Saturday July 18th Came in with light wind from the S. West and clear weather. Schooner with some sails cut. Boiling with Pedro Varela and brother. Boiling no observations.

Sunday July 19th Came in with light wind from the S. West and clear weather. Schooner on port Jack. Boiling in afternoon. Raised School of Small Whales going N.E. Pedro caught one. saw made with him. these saw we put down some oil, we amply and revery provisions. ask that we have on board to put oil in no observations.

Monday July 20th Came in with light wind from the South and clear weather. in morning we finished Boiling and we square with Pedro on oil. made about 80 barrels of oil. and at 9 A.M. we start for Fayal with full ship. Hatch Cord; about 3,800 lb. Lat 32° 59' Long 48° 49' West.

Tuesday July 21th Came in with moderate breeze from the East and clear weather. Schooner under all sails. Hearay C. of East. Crew cooking. Church cash. all day. Lat 34° 15' Long 47° 37'
