Wed. July 22, Came in with very light wind from the East, and clear Weather. Schooner on Starboard tack steering N. E. East; all sails set. Crew washing the Vessel in side pumps attended to.

Thursday July 23rd Came in with calm Weather and clear, Schooner under all sails steering East in after noon saw cakers. Boat went then and caught 24 Solpung in after noon. Took in all sails on account of calm. pumps attended to, Lat 35° 35' Long 47° 03' West.

Friday July 24th Came in with very light wind from S. West and clear Weather, in morning we made sails steering S. by South, crew washing out the hull in sand and pumps attended to, Lat 36° 10' Long 46° 44' West.

Saturday July 25th Stevedore came to his duty, Came in with fresh breeze from the S. West and rain squalls, at times Schooner under all sails steering S. by South on Starboard tack, in after noon we took in main topmast and flying stay sails, we finished washing the Vessel in side and pumps attended to Lat 36° 49' Long 44° 19' West.

Sunday July 26th Came in with strong S. West wind and squally Weather and rain in morning we took in main sail and flying top Schooner on Starboard tack steering S. East, pumps attended to Stevedore attended to duty.

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Monday July 27th Came in with fresh breeze from the S. West and rain squalls, Schooner under all sails steering S. East, on port tack, crew washing the Vessel in side and cleaning up iron works and pumps attended to.

Lat 37° 41' Long 38° 05' West.
Tuesday July 28th Came in with good breeze from the S. West and clear Weather, all sails set on Starboard tack steering S. by S. East. Crew cleaning up iron works and paint them pumps attended to saw 4 Marchant men going N. East, Lat 38° 06' Long 35° 30' West.

Wednesday July 29th Came in with dead calm all day. No sails out. Crew finished iron works and paint all of them, Brockett Barrel of Beef, pumps attended to saw ends this day. Lat 38° 05' Long 34° 57' West.

Thursday July 30th Came in with calm Weather very light wind from the S. West, Schooner under all sails just moving along we saw lots of sperm whales. we paint West Boat, and top of House, pumps attended to, Lat 38° 14' Long 31° 16' West.

Friday July 31st Came in with dead calm and a hard sun, this day we scrap the masts and shush them down in after noon spring up little breeze from South we made all sails on Starboard tack steering S. East, kept fixing up Starboard Boat. Lat 38° 09' Long 31° 10' West.

Saturday August 1st Came in with light wind from the S. West, and clear Weather all sails set on Starboard tack steering S. East, we finished Starboard Boat. Lat 38° 19' Long 30° 02' West.
