August the 12th came in with light wind from the West and clear Weather. Schooner under all sails biting to the windward we saw Grampasses. Crew scraping iron work and paint them. pumps attended to
Lat 36 25 Long 33 58 West

Thursday August 13th came in with light wind from the West and clear Weather. Schooner under all sails standing by the wind on port tack. at sun down took ship on starboard tack. at later part calm we took in all sails. Lat 35 35 Long 34 46 West

Friday August 14th came in with light wind from the West. Schooner under all sails standing to the Westward. Crew scraping iron work at sun down took in fore sail
Lat 35 54 Long 35 45 West

August 15th came in with very light wind from the N West and clear Weather. Schooner under all sails working to the Westward. Saw Black fish Killer and Grampasses. at sun down took sails and lay on starboard tack
Lat 36 43 Long 36 20 West

Saturday August 16th came in with calm in morning at 7 A M sprang up little breeze from the S West at 8 we made sails and raised 5 Boil Whales. at 10 we lower two Boils. L. B. Thuck 10 Barrel Whale and L. B. had one mist we took the Wal aboing side at 3 P M. we got 8 cals up ready to cut in

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Sunday August 17th came in with moderate breeze from the West and clear Weather. and suns sea on in morning we commenced to cut in at 3 P M finished we clear way the Head and took 8 cals down and at 7 P M cart fire Boiling
Lat 35 40 Lon 36 25

Monday August 18th came in with light wind from the West and clear Weather. Schooner under all sails on port tack under port sail Boiling no observation

Tuesday August 19th came in with fresh breeze from the West and rain. Signals. Schooner under short sail Boiling at 7 30 P M finished 56 Barrels full every cask that we had on board
Lat 35 15 Long 36 36

Wednesday August 20th came in with good breeze from the East and clear Weather. Schooner under short sail on port tack standing on wire. Crew washing the vessel in salt water at 10 A M we raised a school of Boil Whales from the back we lower two Boils. L. B. Thuck saw we got one that took in along side at noon we got dinner and got gears up and cut in the Whale we have to lat. Head gone because we have no casks to put all of the oil at 4 P M took 8 cals down and set for sail and firing
