Tuesday Sept 1st Schooner at anchor at Fayal acoris this day we breacked oil and cook every cask, refect them and march. then ready to ship, one watch went on shore every night and before late than have some money every night saw ends this day

Wed. Sept 2nd at Fayal acoris this day we shipped some oil to Harry Smith and Breackwith some more and cook them ready for ship, saw ends this day

Thursday Sept 3rd at anchor at Fayal acoris, light wind from N East and some rain. Squalls at Fune we scrub the vessel out side and in

Friday Sept 4th comes in with light wind from the N. West and clear Weather, we ship one lighter of oil to Harry Smith, and Breackwith the rest of oil and cook them well and refect, all ready to ship when Harry Smith is ready to back them saw ends this day

Sat Sept 5th comes in with fine Weather, Schooner at Fayal acoris, this day we send last of oil to Harry Smith that we have on board. saw ends this day

Sunday Sept 6th at Fayal acoris no work to be done light wind from the S West, part watch went on shore all day.

Monday Sept 7th at Fayal acoris with light wind from the S West and clear Weather 5 of the crew refuse duty and to go on shore. to see the consul and their went on shore to see consul after some talk with consul their return to the ship all right saw ends day.

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Tuesday Sept 8th at anchor at Fayal with strong breeze from the S West, this day we took some hooks and Provisions from Harry Smith and we commenced to set up casks we are shore Cooper on board. saw ends this day

Wed. Sept 9th at anchor at Fayal with strong wind from the S West, and clear Weather we have seting up casks saw ends this day and we took on board some casks from shore and commenced to stow the Hall

Thursday Sept 10 at Fayal. from this day to last-

" 11 of this month we set up cask.
 " 12 and stow off the Hord and
 " 13 got some 250 Baril of fresh
 " 14 Water and we Paint Ship
 " 15 and gave liberty to the crew
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Wednesday Sept 30 at Fayal with strong Gale from the S West and rain. Vessel all ready for sea we waiting for the next Pinnular with slop and cutting falls
