

Wednesday Feb 17th came in with calm weather and thick fog at anchor at Parafal we stowed the boat and made ready for sea

Thursday Feb 18th came in with foggy weather strong breeze and side the boat of and made all ready for sea

Friday Feb 19 we sail from Parafal forward to leave we found very strong trade at noon we took in main sail and flying jib, vessel steering S by East

Saturday Feb 20 we came to anchor at Parafal for Harbour we got in at 2 P.M. moved the vessel and washed of out side from this date up to 5 day of March we lay at Parafal for Harbour and we sail on 5 day of March for Malung Weather moderate some, we painted vessel out, sit and took stores from the schooner Tubuna and was sent out from Home

Sunday March 6 came in with light wind and clear weather Schooner under all sails standing on Starboard tack heading N.W. West, saw Pofasses Lat 15, 50 Long 26, 46 West

Monday March 7. came in with light wind and clear weather at anchor in side Breakout Flower and Bee Lat 16, 50 Long 26, 11

Thursday March 8th came in with very light trades and clear weather Schooner under all sails working in to N. West saw Pofasses, we broke out Bread and fire Wood, in after noon calm we took main Tofusid, Lat 17, 31 Long 26, 33 West

Friday March 9th came in with calm weather and clear in after noon spring up little breeze we made sails steering West, at 5, 30 P.M. we raised large Whale going to the leeward we dropped boats to try the only chance that we had before night Whale came up to far cannot get to him at sun set Boats came on board we took in sails, this day we put one new coil of tow line in L Boats tub and overhauled all of other lines and clean up tryworks, Lat 17, 45 Long 26, 59

Saturday March 10th came in with light wind from the N. East and clear weather in morning we made sails and Tigrag to the leeward at noon we hold up on wind biting up saw Black fishs and Pofasses, at sun down took in sails, saw ends the day pump attended to, Lat 17, 18 Long 26, 39 West

Sunday March 11th came in with light wind from the trade and clear weather, Schooner under all sails biting to the windward saw Pofasses, Crew making sunset and backwinkle at sun down we took in sails Lat 17, 13 Long 26, 59 W.

Monday March 12th came in with light wind from the trade and clear weather, Schooner under all sails steering off - West by North, saw finbacks, Crew making sunset and backwinkle Lat 17, 10 Long 29, 20 West
