

Sunday March 13th came in with light trades and clear weather, schooner under all sails on Starboard tack running off Steaming West by North, pumps attended to saw ends these days Lat 16,21 Long 31,00 W.

Monday March 14th came in with light wind from the land and clear weather, schooner under all sails on Starboard tack Steaming W. N. West - these days we Broke out Water and some oil to use and made some senet, pumps attended to Lat 14,25 Long 32,31 West

Thursday March 15th came in with strong trades and rain squalls. at noon we took in main sail and topsail set main trysail, crew making senet and other jobs Lat 14,40 Long 35,25 West

Wednesday March 16th came in with fresh trades and clear weather, schooner under short sail running off an evening back crew making senet pumps attended to Lat 14,45 Long 37,25 West

Thursday March 17th came in with strong trades and rain squalls, schooner under short sail working to the Westward, at sun down took in jibs crew making senet and making some chafing gear Lat 14,53 Long 38,35 West

Friday March 18th came in with strong trades and squally weather, vessel under short sail working to the Westward, crew making senet, vessel Steaming of W. N. West, at sun down took in two jibs Lat 14,31 Long 40,14 West

Saturday March 19th came in with strong trades and clear weather, schooner under short sails Steaming S. West on port tack at sun down took in two jibs Lat 13,09 Long 42,14 West

Sunday March 20th came in with fresh trades, schooner under short sails Steaming of W. N. West on Starboard tack at sun down took in flying jib Lat 12,13 Long 44,21 West

Monday March 21th came in with fresh trades and clear weather, schooner under all sails running off on Starboard tack Steaming off W. N. West at 2 P.M. we Raised School of small Whales going quick to the windward we dropped boats upwind off and went to the windward Whales going so quick that boats could not get to the windward of them at 5-30 P.M. Boats came on board, we took in the main sail and bit to the windward all night under short sails Lat 12,36 Long 44,28 West

Thursday March 22th came in with fresh trades and clear weather, in morning we set main sail, and bit to the windward all day saw nothing at sun down we took in sails and lay on Starboard tack we made new mast for L.B. pump attended to Lat 12,32 Long 44,77

Wednesday March 23th came in with fresh trades and cloudy weather, schooner under all sails working to Westward, pumps attended to Lat 12,39 Long 45,72
