Thursday 24th Barnes in with fresh trades and clear weather schooner under all sails running off steering W by N. been working on main top sail. and we fix up Lib and flyer Lib parents pumps attended to Lat 12.42 Long 47.58

Friday March 25th Barnes in with strong trade wind and clear weather schooner under all sails steering off W. N. West at noon we bent main topmast at 3.30 P.M. we raised school of small Whales close to the vessel. Whales was gain to the windward we lower two boats and fast to the windward. finally mate got chase on the Whales he fool on to them with good chase. Boat steerer West the Whales dart his river over the Whales back dead not get fast then the Whales went to the windward. boat chase until night and came on board. enough none we short in sails

Saturday March 26th Barnes in with squally and rainy weather all day. schooner under short sail. at 10 A.M. we cast off steering W by N. at noon gib ship steering W by N. observed

Sunday March 27th Barnes in with fresh trades and clear weather. schooner under all sails steering W by North. pumps attended to.

Monday March 28th Barnes in with fresh trades and clear weather. all sails set steering W by N. crew making sent and pumps attended to Lat 11.42 Long 52.51 West

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Thursday March 29th Barnes in with strong trades and clear weather schooner under main sail fore stays and Lib steering off West at 4 P.M. we are 85 m. from Barbados Lat 12.56 Long 58.10 West

Wednesday March 30th Barnes in with moderate trades at 2 A.M. we sighted Pointe à Pitre on weather bow at 7 A.M. we came to anchor at Barbados in 6 fathom of water, saw ends this day.

Thursday March 31th at Barbados with rain squalls and fresh trades we took on board 1 bunching of molasses 3 barrel of Flour, Sugar Bags of Beans Bag of Pear. Box of Onions and bag of Corn, saw ends this day.

Friday March April 1st at Barbados, with fresh trades and rain squalls we took on board some small stores saw ends this day.

Thursday April 2nd 3 4 5-6 at Barbados waiting order April 7th sail from Barbados to Dominica we got foul British Bark and easy way. flying Lib boom

Friday April 8th arrived at Dominica at 7 A.M. found here St. John's City. we rock out look and took Head cash ready to set up casks.

Saturday April 9th Barnes in with squally weather and rain we commence to set up casks and do some trading. Bark Berth arrived
