May 7th Schooner Adelia Chase Log Book
 commenced May 7th 1904
 at 1 P.M. we sail from the St. Custer
 for Whaling cruise, with light-trade wind
 we set all sails Steaming N. N. West- Back
 Borth and W. A. Grover sail same day
 we took on board 11 Barrels of Sweet
 Potatoes and 6 Barrel of Jamies and
 few cases of Gin for the crew.

Friday May 10th Calmer in with light trades and clear
 Weather Schooner under all sails Stea-
 ring N. N. West Grover in hour camp-
 ing we threw away chains and paint
 Heredes, and some other iron works
 anegada in sight of becken.

Wed. May 11th Calmer in with light-trades and
 Clear Weather Schooner under all sails
 on Starboard tack Steaming off N. N. West-
 crew employed on painting iron works
 around shipworks and cover and
 top of Galley, and pump attended to
 to. Lat 21-00 Long 65-27

Thursday May 12th Calmer in with light trades and
 rainy Weather all sails set on Starboard
 tack Steaming off N. W. by North. Grover
 in sight we grind down spades and
 mowing knives, pumps attended to
 Lat 21-48 Long 65-59 West

Friday May 13th Calmer in with light wind from
 the East and rainy Weather Schooner
 under all sails Steaming N. by West Grover
 in sight pumps attended to
 Lat 22-10 Long 66-04 West
