Saturday May 14th came in with light Trade wind and clear weather Schooner under all sails Steaming N.W. West. In rear went out light crew making some dory and pump attended to howe Land deck's shakedown looking thick

Sunday May 15th came in with very light wind from the East and clear weather, Schooner under all sails Steaming off N.W. by North pumps attended to.

Lat 24.41 Long 68.49 West

Monday May 16th came in with light South by wind and rain Squally in morning Schooner under all sails on part tack Steaming off N.W. at noon we came up an iron barge about 70 feet long before to be loaded with fish. we caught 200 fish, we cannot let fire on Sun bet it was second and solet, it was in lat 25.41 North

Long 59.50 West

Tuesday May 17th came in with light wind from the South and clear weather. Schooner under all sails on part tack Steaming off N.W. this day we repair for Mays and pumps attended to.

Lat 26.32 Long 70.22 West

Wednesday May 18th first part came in with fresh breeze from the South and rain and Squally weather at noon we took in main sail and flying Gib later part with heavy rain Squalls at 10 P.M. we took in Gib pumps attended to sun obscure no observations taking

Lat and Long by dead reckoning 28.40 Long 72.70 West

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Thursday May 19th all through this 24th came in with Squally weather and rain, variable wind, Schooner under short sail, working in north west pump attended to no observations sun obscure

Friday May 20th came in with Steady rain all through day and light variable wind, Schooner under short sail must all day, trying to work in to North west - no sun sighted for the last five days, pumps attended to no observations taking

Lat by dead reckoning 30.48 Long 73.13 West

Saturday May 21st came in with dead calm all day and very clear weather all sails in. in account of calm, we brackant stop to splice the crew and sortage casks we rose of new main boom tackle fall and new Gib down hal and fore boom tackle fall, how ends this day

Lat 31.00 Long 73.47 West

Sunday May 22nd came in with light wind variable all sail set working to Northward in afternoon we took in all sails dead calm, pumps attended to.

Lat 34.12 Long 74.17 West

Monday May 23rd came in with dead calm all day no sail bare set, we Paint V.B. and do some other jobs, saw four mast schooner bound South and Steamer also, bound South, at 5 P.M. late breeze from East we set fore sail and Gib Steaming North pumps attended to

Lat 34.13 Long 74.39 West
