Wed June 1st came in with very light wind from East and clear weather all sails set working to Westward in forenoon we took one cask of Oil from Grosear 5 Barrels in afternoon we Raised school of Small Whales, we lower Boats made a with Grosear we caught one saw Whale the rest went to the windward P. A. B. caught the Whale took him along side at 4 P.M. we got gear up and saw of the Hel, however this day Lat 36.39 Long 74.12 West

Thursday June 2nd came in with light wind from the South and clear weather in morning we cut in the Whale took gear down and start fire Grosear in side pumps attended to Lat 36.30 Long 74.05

Frid June 3rd came in with light wind from West and thick fog must all day at 4 P.M. clear up we spoke Grosear at sun down shorting sails

Sat June 4th came in with light wind from the East in morning we Raised Whales in company with Grosear. we caught 1 Whale in morning lower B. Boat Grosear took this Whale along side, in afternoon we Raised lots of Whales we caught 1. Grosear 2 we took one Whale from the Grosear we got cutting gear up ready to cut in next morning: we were Boiling at sun down took in sails Lat 36.33 Long 73.37

caught 4 Whales
Grosear took 2

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Sunday June 5th came in with light wind from the S West and clear weather. at day light we commence to cut in, at 6.20 A.M. we Raised large Whale gain S.W. we lower one boat, Grosear one, chase but caught none, boats came on board we finished cut in at 9 o'clock. we made sails standing to Westward at 4 P.M. we Raised school of small Whales gain S West we caught one Whale. A. B. and third mate of Grosear caught one also. we took the Whale along side at 6 P.M. we got supper and set watch. Boiling sun ends this day Lat 36.40 Long 73.04

Monday June 6th came in with good breeze from the S West and very rough seas and swells running at 7 A.M. we commence to cut the Whale that we got yesterday at 9 we finished took gear down were around on part took set Gibs we clear up the Head and start fire again Grosear in side at sun down took in sails Lat 37.29 Long 73.16 West

Thursday June 7th came in with light wind from the S West and clear weather schooner under all sails but foresail Boiling in company with W. A. Grosear at 10 P.M. weather squally we finished Boiling at sun down we took in sails and then day we put fore sail down Lat 37.25 Long 73.34 W
