

Thursday June 16th Came in with light S West wind and clear weather, all sails set cruising 2 Whalers in side in afternoon spoke Golding City at 6 P.M. saw 2 more Whaling Sch. on weather Bow at sun down we took in sails and lay on port tack heading to the westward we now new falls on West Boat saw ends this day

Lat 37.05 Long 73.29

Friday June 17th Came in with light East wind and clear weather, Schooner under all sails cruising 4 Whalers in side in afternoon we spoke C.A. Swift crew making keret pumps attended to, at sun down we short in sails and lay on port tack

Lat 36.56 Long 73.48 W

Sat June 18th Came in with light wind from the S West and clear weather in morning we made sails and stand to the Westward, 4 Whaling Sch. in side at 4 P.M. we spoke C.B. Concof. at sun set we took in sails and lay on port tack crew making keret and pumps attended to

Lat 36.40 Long 74.01 W

Sunday June 19th Came in with fresh breeze from the S West and clear weather in morning we hove round on Starboard tack made all sails Steaming S East we saw C.B. Concof caught. What we chase but can get none, Short in sails

Lat 37.11 Long 73.01

Monday June 20th Came in with fresh breeze from S West and clear weather, in morning we made all sails at 6.30 A.M. we Raised Whales in company with W.A. Grozeau made us caught 2 Whales Grozeau caught 5, we lost one (S.B. L.B.) got gear up and cut in the two Whales finished at 3 P.M. took bear down and clearway the heads at 7 P.M. Start fire

Lat 37.29 Long 72.17

Tuesday June 21th Came in with strong and foggy weather and rain in morning we took one Whale from the Grozeau we got gear up and cut in the Whale at noon finished got gear down and start fire again we took in main sail and hove around on port tack Steaming of North Grozeau with this very rough weather Bailing under 2 try sail and for a stay haul, S.B. got stove.

Lat 38.0 Long 74.4 West

Wednesday June 22th Came in with very strong S West breeze and foggy sea on Bailing under two try sails Grozeau also Bailing Sch. Standing on port tack we pump out some fresh Water and put some Oil down pumps attended to saw ends this day

Lat 38.42 Long 75.55

Grozeau took care of 4 Whalers these took care of 3
