Grosear with his Boiling at 9 A.M. we made Land and Gylt Ship on Port tack. we stow down all of oil and clear up decks in Whales made 47 25-Gals at Sun down took in Sails

Friday June 24th Came in with light breeze from the S West Schooner under all Sails, we Raised lots Whales we caught 2 Whales Grosear caught 3 took them along side at 3 P.M. we cut them in finished at 6 P.M. we start Boiling again

Saturday June 25th Came in with light wind from the S West in morning we Raised Whales with Grosear we lower boats, we caught one Whale alive, cut in in and start Boiling again in after noon we Raised Whales again, we caught 2 more and Grosear caught 2 also took the Whales along side at 6 P.M. and start Boiling again, we Brochant Beef.

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Sunday June 26th Came in with very rough weather strong S.W. wind and rough seas on we reef main Sails and start to cut the Whales it was very unpleasant cutting in but we got both Whales in finished at noon, Grosear in side in morning, we hove round, and start Port tack Steaming N.W. West to get out stream at 3 P.M. took in main Sail Sail commence to reef on reef band, we Boiling and brochant Barrel of flour

Lat 38° 17 Long 70° 00 West

Monday June 27th Came in with strong S West breeze and rough Schooner on port tack Boiling, Grosear went out side we pump some fresh Water getting ready to put some oil down under short Sails and pumps attended to

Lat 39° 02 Long 70° 09

Tuesday June 28th Came in with light S West wind and clear weather, Schooner under main Sail and three Head Sail Steaming. We dived on Port tack, Boiling we put down some oil at 8 P.M. we finished Boiling at Sun down we short in Sails pumps attended to Lat 38° 26 Long 71° 18 West

Wednesday June 29th Came in with fine weather light N.E. wind and clear weather, Schooner under all Sails standing to Southward, we stow down oil and clear up decks Whales made 117 Barrels, pumps attended to at Sun down we short in Sails

Lat 38° 32 Long 73° 47 West
