Thursday July 14th came in with light wind from the S West in morning we raised two large Whales. In East we lower Boats made over C. A. Swift - howr 1 Boat stuck 80. Barry Whab. till the Whab and took her along side of Swift we went badly ground up Boiling and with all of howr gunch cook full, 10:30 Swift was entire these Whab her Windlers gear and saws that she cannot get head off. day for the lat Hadd gone 4 Whalers in side. Posen caught Whab also.

Friday July 15th came in with light S West wind and clear weather, in morning we raised Whales go in East, we caught one small Whab made with C. A. Swift we took the Whab along side at 1 P.M. got dinner and put up gears and cut in finished at 4 P.M. took gears down and blew up the Head at 7 P.M. Start fire we took in Main sail

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Friday July 16th came in with fresh breeze from the S West and squally weather, in morning we saw Swift, we two Boats saw Chasing Whales but she caught none Whales go in to Southward we dead not lower Boats in after noon we shorting sails, Golding City in side

Saturday July 17th came in with nice breeze from the S West and clear weather, in morning we raised Whales go in to the windward we made sails and beat to the windward. at noon time we brought the Whab to the leeward of her we lower two Boats, J. B. Hunk and L. B. Hunk we got two small calves took them along side at 4 P.M. we got gears up and cut in 1 Whab. at 7:30 P.M. we got supper and set Watch C. A. Swift had two Boats same in morning way down of howr bee. Sean. at sun down we took in Main Sails and head sails pumps attended to

Sunday July 18th came in with fresh breeze from the S West and clear weather, and rain squall in morning we cut in one Whab and blew up the Head. at 1 P.M. we start fire Golding City in side. in after noon we raised Whales go in S.W. lower two Boats and Whab caught none at sun down Boats came back pumps attended to
