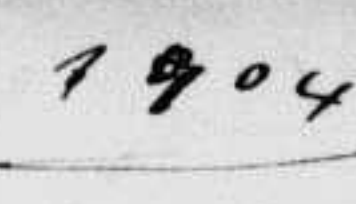


Thursday July 19th 1904  Barnes in with strong breeze from the West. Schooner under short sails Boiling at 9 AM we Raised Water gam to the windward. we beat after them but cannot get near enough to lower Boats, Golding City in side at 11 a minute finished Boiling, at sun down we took in sails, pumps attended to, sun ends the day
Lat 37.20 Long 73.14

Wed July 20th Barnes in with fine weather wind from West in morning we made all sails and stand to Westward in company with Golding City the day we taking up boats we put up 7 casks at sun down we took in sail
Lat 36.50 Long 73.54

Thursday July 21st Barnes in with fresh breeze from the S West and clear weather, in morning we made sails and cruise in company with Golding City. saw lots of porpoises this day we How down oil the last faer made 95 Barrels, Whale made we Cask with made 18. aboard at sun set we took in sails and lay on port tack
36.56 Lat  Long 74.12

Friday July 22nd Barnes in with fresh breeze in morning and squally weather we made sails at 10 AM we Raised One large Whale gain East we lower Boats made with Golding City, but weather came down bad we took Boats up rain spals all afternoon
Lat 36.48 Long 74.18 West

Saturday July 23rd 1904  Barnes in with strong breeze from the West and rough seas on schooner under very short sails standing to the Westward in company with Golding City at sun down we saw Whaling schooner on horizon weather being we took in Lib and pumps attended to
Lat 36.58 Long 74.08

Sunday July 24th Barnes in with strong S West wind and rough seas on schooner under short sails cruising for Whaling Schooner in side at 6 PM took WOA Grozier,
Lat 37.15 Long 74.21 West

Monday July 25th Barnes in with strong S West breeze and rough schooner under short sails running off East Coast at sun down we hove to on starboard tack took in Lib and fore sail pumps attended to
Lat 37.00 Long 73.32

Tuesday July 26th Barnes in with strong breeze from the S West and clear weather in morning we made sails and steer of East, Grozier with his Golding City out side at sun down we took in sails, pumps attended to
Lat 37.42 Long 72.15

Wednesday July 27th Barnes in with fine weather light variable in morning rain squals we Raised Water gam West lower Boats and chase rain squals came on Boats late to calm on board, at noon saw some more, lower again - caught none
Lat 37.50 Long 71.57
