

Saturday August 13th Barnes in with light wind from the S.W. and clear weather schooner under all sails cruising, we saw lots sailing vessels and steamers crew making some repairs and cleaning up iron works, at sun down we took in sails

Sunday August 14th Barnes in with fresh breeze from the S.W. and clear weather in morning we made all sails and stand to northward at 7 a.m. we raised school of small whales, we caught one S.B. male & along the whales fine spray at first off, we took the whales along side at 8.35, put up gears, and set it in at 11 o'clock finished took gears over and clear way the little head at noon & at dinner, at 5 P.M. start boiling at sun down we took in sails and pumps attended to

Monday August 15th Barnes in with light wind from the West and clear weather all sails set cruising at 3 P.M. finished boiling at sun down we took in sails and pumps attended to

Lat 37.50 Long 72.49

Tuesday August 16th Barnes in with strong breeze from the S.W. schooner under short sails standing to the S.W. we put down one cask of oil and got up water on deck in after noon rain squalls all sails took in

Lat 37.50 Long 72.39

Wednesday August 17th Barnes in with strong breeze from the S.W. and rain squalls schooner under short sails, musing been washing the vessel on side and some other job around, at sun down we took in fore sail and lay on port tack pumps attended to one more of July

Thursday August 18th Barnes in with strong breeze schooner under all sails, clearing for home been washing her out side and in we took fore mast pumps attended to

Lat 40.00 Long 70.43 West

Friday August 19th Barnes in with light breeze in morning at noon calm all sails set at 10 a.m. saw Black Island 20 miles off and lots of fishing vessel, at noon calm, at 5 P.M. spring up little breeze from South vessel steaming West by East, Green September cork, and Chapman masts saw under the day

Saturday August 20th Barnes in with strong East breeze and rain squalls, schooner under all sails working in comes to anchor at Coventry ground at 5.30 A.M. crew taking up cutting dudge and both things and both at 11 a.m. we got to Central Wharf, son end of this voyage Larina
