Friday Oct 28<sup>th</sup> Came in with fresh breeze from the South and Clear Weather Vessel under reef main sail and head sail, Steaming S by South on Starboard tack. Crew making sand and other jobs, pumps attended to. Lat 32 01 Long 52 50

Saturday Oct 29<sup>th</sup> Came in with strong breeze from the South and heavy sun. Schooner on Starboard tack heading S by East - under low sail only. Crew fixing up boats and other jobs around, pumps attended to. Lat 32, 24 Long 50, 45

Sunday Oct 30<sup>th</sup> Came in with light East wind and Clear Weather Schooner under all sail. Heading on wind on Starboard tack. Pumps attended to. Lat 32 33. Long 47 45 West

Monday Oct 31<sup>st</sup> Came in with light East wind and Clear Weather all sails set. Heading to the windward, crew making sand and we working on the boat rigging up, pumps attended to. Star Band of Argon, Lat 32, 34 Long 45 05

Thursday November 1<sup>st</sup> Came in with light wind from the S.W. Schooner under all sails Steaming East - we beat S.W. sails and we sawed over the spindents and set up our spout gages, and pumps attended to. Lat 32 07 Long 42, 10

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Tuesday November 2<sup>nd</sup> Came in with light Easty wind and Clear Weather Schooner under all sails. Raising later part calm, we ran our laneyards on main rigging on front side and making sand and fresh bedding on main deck, and pumps attended to. Lat 32, 13 Long 42 55 West

Wednesday Nov 3<sup>rd</sup> Came in with light Southy wind and Clear Weather Schooner under all sails on Starboard tack, Steaming S. by East. Crew washing the vessel in side and we put our laneyard on main rigging, pumps attended to. Lat 31-50 Long 40, 55 West

Friday Nov 4<sup>th</sup> Came in with nasty Weather Gale from the South. Schooner under two stay sails and fore stay sail. Raising to, and rain squalls. Boats on up fleet and aback. Bating down, and pumps attended to every hour, Lat Long none

Saturday Nov 5<sup>th</sup> Came in with strong N West wind and rough seas. Schooner under stay sails and reef fore sail. In afternoon moderate some we took reef of fore sail and set G.B. at 7 P.M. we set reef main sail, Steaming S.W. (Lat) Saw two mast Schooner on Weather quarter under fore sail and reef main. Sail standing to to Starward, Lat 31 30 Long 37 29 West

Sunday Nov 6<sup>th</sup> Came in with strong breeze from the S.W. and Clear Weather. Schooner under reef sails on Starboard tack Steaming S. by East at 6 P.M. we set flying G.B. and pumps attended to. Lat 32 27 Long 35 17 West
