Wednesday Dec. 7 Sail from Brava, for cruise With strong
Wind from the trade, Schooner under try
fore sail and Lib, pump attended to every
hour.

Thursday Dec. 8 Came in With strong trade under try
and Lib we overhaul line tubs of both boats
we put on new short of line in them
pump attended to.

Lat 16° 25' N Long 26° 01' W.

Friday Dec. 9 Came in With very strong trade, and heavy
sea on Schooner on port tack under try
and Lib working to the windward pump attended
to. — Lat 17° 56' N Long 26° 26' W.

Saturday Dec. 10 Came in With strong Wind from the trade
schooner on Starboard tack under two try
sails and Lib, working to the windward
pump attended to.

Lat 17° 43' N Long 26° 01' W.

Sunday Dec. 11 Came in With strong trade and clear
Weather Schooner under short sails working to
the windward pump attended to.

Lat 18° 42' N Long 26° 20' W.

Monday Dec 12 Came in With strong trade and clear
Weather Schooner under short sails on Starboard
tack working to the windward, this day
we sepay the crew with selay chest and
Brockout, Baril of Flower and start cask
of Brud, some a marchante Bark goin to
South, pump attended to.

Lat 18° 00' N Long 26° 02' W.

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Tuesday Dec 13 Came in With moderate trade and
squaly Weather and rain in morning we
set fore sail on starboard tack, at noon
we were round on port tack working
to the windward, we brockout Water and
Beans, at sun set took in fore sail set fore
trysail, pump attended to.

Lat 18° 33' N Long 26° 30' W.

Wednesday Dec. 14 Came in With moderate trade, and
clear Weather, all sails set on starboard tack
heading NE East, crew making senet, at sun
set took in sails, were round on Port tack,
standing on Windward, pump attended to.

Lat 18° 40' N Long 26° 05' W.

Thursday Dec. 15 Came in With light trade and
smud sea, all sails set standing on Windward
on Port tack, we set up fore main, riggine
Brockout, Baril Reef, some a Marchantsman
goin to South, at sun set shorting sails, were
round on Starboard tack, pump attended to.

Lat 18° 00' N Long 25° 40' W.

Friday Dec 16 Came in With light Wind from the trade
all sails set, on Starboard tack working
to the windward, some a Marchant Bark
goin to South, at 4 P.M. Raised school of small
Whales, lower two boats, SB Struck young Bull
and the others went to the windward, we took
the Whale long side at dark, hayed boats up
and shorting sails.

Lat 18° 26' N Long 26° 14' W.

Saturday Dec 17 Came in With light Wind from the North and
clear Weather, at 1 P.M. in morning we come in to cut in
at 11 P.M. finish took gear down and come in to clear
up the head, we find on Whal, great quantities of hainbag
about seventy Bund, at 4 P.M. start fire, at sun set took in
main sail set main try sail, shrou on Port tack (No observation)
