Wednesday

January 18 Came in with very strong trade and clear weather with rough sea on Schooner under two try sail and fore sail, in morning were round on Starboard tack, standing on windward, in afternoon more moderate wind we set fore, Broome, Raa Corn etc, pumps carefully attended

Lat 18.20 Long 23.21 W.

Thursday

Jan 19 Came in with moderate wind from the trade and clear weather, with rough sea on Schooner under two try sail and fore. Standing on wind on Port tack, crew employed repairing flying jib, pumps attended to

Lat 18.55 Long 23.25

Friday

Jan 20 Came in with strong wind from the trade and clear weather with high sea on Schooner under two try sail and fore. Standing to windward, on Port tack, we Broome water, pumps carefully attended

Lat 18.30 Long 23.14

Saturday

January 21 First part of the day fresh trade and clear weather, and latter parts strong wind with squalls, vessel on Port tack under two try sail and fore, at noon were round on Starboard tack, took in jib standing on wind, pumps carefully attended

This day no observation

Sunday

Jan 22 Came in with strong trade and rough sea on, Schooner, under two try sail and fore, running off NW West, at sun set took in jib, pumps carefully attended

Lat 18.13 Long 23.44 W

Monday

January 23 Came in with strong trade with rough sea on, Schooner on Starboard tack, running off steering off NW by W. under two try sail and fore, pumps carefully attended

Lat 18.24 Long 25.32

Tuesday

January 24 Came in with moderate trade with rain, in morning we set fore try sail on starboard tack working to windward at noon were round on Port tack, in afternoon spoke to "Golden City" at sun set took in fore sail set fore try sail, pumps attended to

Lat 18.42 Long 25.36

Wednesday

Jan 25 Came in with strong trade and squalls with rough sea on, Schooner under short sail working to windward on Port tack, in company with "Golden City", at 5 P.M. took in fore sail set fore try sail, pumps carefully attended

No observation, sun obscure

Thursday

Jan 26 Came in with strong wind from the trade, and squalls all day, with rough sea in morning were round on Starboard tack standing on windward, under short sail spoke a merchant bark going to South - "Golden City", out of sight, pumps carefully attended

Lat 18.20 Long 26.04

Friday

Jan 27 Came in with fine weather and light wind from the trade, in morning we set main sail, on Starboard tack, steering off NW. at set up head gears and braced flying jib at noon were ship to Southward at sun set took in sail, and lay on Starboard tack

Lat 18.50 Long 26.21
