Feb 7 Came in with fresh breeze from the trade, and foggy weather, Schooner under short sail on Port tack reaching to the Windward, Crew making sunt at sunset took in fore sail set fore try sail, were round on Starboard tack, pump carefully attended to
Lat 17° 31' Long 25° 21'

Wednesday

February 8 Came in with moderate trade and foggy weather, in morning we set fore sail, and were round on Port tack, beating to the windward, at sun set took in fore sail set fore try sail, and were round lay on Starboard tack, pump attended to
Lat 17° 33' Long 25° 11'

Thursday

February 9 Came in with light wind from the trade, and foggy weather, vessel under all sail set on Port tack, beating to Windward at noon we sighted St. Anthony at 6 PM we was near to the land, we took in main sail were round on Starboard tack standing to the Windward, pump attended to
No observation

Friday

February 10 Came in with light wind from the trade and foggy weather, Schooner under all sail set beating up to St. Anthony at 2 PM we lower SB. Capt went on shore for letter, come on Board at 3 PM we start to St. Vincent, pump attended to
No observation

Saturday

February 11 Came in with very light wind from the trade and foggy weather vessel under all sail set bound to St. Vincent at 2 PM we lower SB. Capt went shore come on Board at 4 PM we start off to Brava, pump attended to
no observation

Sunday

February 12 Come to anchor at Brava with fine weather, more the vessel and let the crew going on shore see they could

Monday

February 13 at Brava crew wash the Vessel but not and Brought some fresh water and Beef and supply the crew with Ship Chest

Tuesday

February 14 at Brava, with fine weather carpenter repairing the Vessel, crew making Oron

Wednesday

February 15 Sail from Brava for cruise with light wind from the North and foggy weather, all sail set on Starboard tack pump attended to

Thursday

February 16 Came in with calm all day no sail out, in afternoon little breeze from the trade we set fore sail and Flying jib standing to Windward on Starboard tack, pump attended to
Lat 15° 20' N Long 24° 58' W

Friday

February 17 Came in with fresh breeze from the East and rough sea with thick fog, vessel under fore sail, main sail and jib running off, steering off N by W. pump carefully attended to
Lat 16° 19' Long 26° 03'

Saturday

February 18 Came in with very strong wind from the trade and rough sea on with foggy weather, Schooner under two try sail and fore try sail, standing to the Windward on Starboard tack, saw a Steamer going to West, pump carefully attended to
Lat 17° 24' N Long 26° 48' W

Sunday

Feb 19 Came in with strong trade with heavy sea, in morning were round on Port tack, Schooner two try sails and jib standing to the Windward, at sunset were round on Starboard tack, pump carefully attended to
Lat 17° 31' Long 26° 55' W
