March 4 Came in with very strong trade with heavy sea running, in morning were round on Port tack, vessel under short sail standing to the windward, vessel shipping much water on deck, pump carefully attended every hour, we mended the Flying jib

March 5 Came in with very strong wind from the trade and rough sea running, vessel under short sails, standing to windward on Port tack, saw a merchant bark bound to S. West, at 6 P.M. were round on Starboard tack, vessel shipping much water on deck pump carefully attended every hour

March 6 Came in with moderate trade with foggy weather, in morning we set fore sail on Port tack, standing to the windward, crew repairing the Flying jib at sun set took in fore sail set fore try sail and were round on Starboard tack, standing to northward, pump carefully attended
