Tuesday April 4 Came in with fresh breeze
from the trade and clear weather Schooner
under main try sail fore sail and head sails
running off N.W. by W. the day we brooked
Melace and hard bread, pump attended to
Lat 15.20 Long 38.40 W.

Wednesday April 5 Came in with fresh breeze from
the trade and clear weather Schooner under
short sail, steering N.W. by W. pump attended
to every two hours
Lat 15.49 Long 38.28 W.

Thursday April 6 Came in with moderate trade
and clear weather Schooner under main
try sail fore sail and jib, steering S.W. by W.
Steward still sick, pump attended to
Lat 16.01 Long 37.45 W.

Friday April 7 Came in with fresh wind from
the trade and clear weather Schooner
under try sail fore sail head sails, steering
S.W. by W. Saw a merchant Bark bound to
north, Steward still sick, off duty.
pump attended to, Lat 16.35 Long 37.03 W.

Saturday April 8 Came in with moderate trade and
clear weather Schooner under main try sail
fore sail and jib, steering off S.W. by W. Crew
repairing fore try sail, Steward little better
pump attended to Lat 13.04 Long 40.15 W.

Sunday April 9 Came in with fresh trade and squally
weather Vessel under short sail on starboard
tack working to the westward, pump attended
to
Lat 13.03 Long 41.26 W.
