Monday April 10 Came in with fresh breeze from the trade and clear weather, Schooner under short, steering WNW, we brockout barrel Beef, and Pork, and fresh Water, - Steward letter later, pump attended to
Leatt 12.00.00 Long 43.43

Tuesday April 11 Came in with fresh wind from the trade and clear weather Schooner under short sails working to the westward, at 4.30 P.M. Raised school of Small Whales, we caught two on each Boat, took Whales along side at dark and took up Boats
Leatt 12.18 Long 45.59 W.

Wednesday April 12 Came in with fresh breeze from the trade, and rough sea, in morning we get gear up and commence to cut in at 10 o'clock finished, took gear down, at 6 P.M. start Boiling, pump attended to
Leatt 12.21 Long 46.35 W.

Thursday April 13 Came in with moderate trade and clear weather, Schooner under short sails on Steward's task, working to the westward at 6 P.M. finish Boiling then day we put oil down and stow off the hole, pump attended to
Leatt 12.25 Long 48.17

Friday April 14 Came in with fine breeze from the trade and clear weather, Vessel under fore sail, trysail and head sail steering WNW, Crew wash the vessel in side pump attended to
Leatt 12.47 Long 50.19 W.

Saturday April 15 Came in with fine breeze from the trade and clear weather, Schooner under, main trysail fore sail and jib, 2 Flying jib, steering WNW, Crew making Oron, pump attended to
Leatt 12.03 Long 52.24 W.

Monday April 16 Came in with moderate trade and clear weather, Schooner under trysail fore sail and head sail working to the westward, pump attended to
Leatt 13.31 Long 54.19 W.

Tuesday April 17 Came in with fresh breeze from the trade and clear weather Vessel under short sails steering WNW, Crew working on fore trysail, pump attended every two hours
Leatt 14.01 Long 55.58 W.

Wednesday April 18 Came in with fresh trade with squally weather. Vessel under short sails steering WNW, Crew working on fore trysail, pump attended to
Leatt 14.25 Long 58.09

Thursday April 19 Came in with fresh wind from the trade, and clear weather, Vessel under short sail working to the Westward, pump attended to
Leatt 15.06 Long 61.00 W.

Friday April 20 Came to anchor at Dominica with fresh trade and clear weather we found here Mr. Beckwith, Golden City, and E. P. Cownel, and Bug come to oil, we brockout and put some back on shore.

Saturday April 21 at Dominica with rain and squalls all day we pump out caulk some salt water

Sunday April 22 at Dominica with squally weather and rain all day, we trade some Corn and Butterfat, we took one Caask of fresh Water on board.

Monday April 23 at Dominica with squall and rain we commence to brockout oil and trade for James and Benanas

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
