Saturday May 13 Came in with fine breeze from the trades and clear weather, in morning we set main sails on Starboard tack, the N.W. crew making sure the Second Mate feel better, pump attended to.

Sunday May 14 Came in with fine breeze from the S.East and clear weather, Schooner under all sails set on Starboard tack steering N.W. North. Second Mate still sick off duty, pump attended to.

Lat 23.34 N Long 66.08

Monday May 15 Came in with good breeze from the S.East, and clear weather, Schooner under all sails set on Starboard tack steering N.W. North. the Second Mate off duty sick, crew making sure, pump attended to.

Lat 25.08 Long 68.34 W.

Tuesday May 16 Came in with fresh breeze from the S.East and clear weather, Schooner under all sail set, running off N.W. the Second Mate still sick, off duty. crew making sure, pump attended to.

Lat 26.50 Long 70.09 W.

Wednesday May 17 Came in with fresh S.East Wind and clear weather, Vessel under all sails set, steering N.W. at 6 P.M. we took in main sail set main try sail, pump attended to.

Lat 29.15 N Long 71.33 W.

Thursday May 18 Came in with light wind from the N.West and rain all day, Schooner under short sails standing to the Windward on Port tack, Saw a Merchant Bark going to Westward. Second Mate still sick. Pump attended to.

Lat 29.53 Long 73.14 W.

Friday May 19 Came in with very light Wind from the N.West and clear weather, Vessel under all sails set, beting up to the Windward, crew employ to make cover for main sail - Second Mate feel better, Saw a four mast Schooner bound to S.West, pump attended to.

Saturday May 20 Came in with light wind from the S.West, and clear weather, Vessel under all sail set steering N.W. 1/2 S. in afternoon began to squall in rain we took main sail and set main try sail, crew finish cover for main sail, Second Mate still sick off duty, pump attended to.

Lat 30.53 Long 73.28

Sunday May 21 Came in with fresh North East Wind and rough sea in morning, Schooner under short sails, steering North, in afternoon Wind light we set all sails, Second Mate feel better, pump attended to, Saw a Steamer going to North West.

Lat 31.45 N Long 74.31 W.

Monday May 22 Came in with fresh breeze from the Southeast and squalls with rain all day, Schooner under short sails, running off N.W. the Second Mate Frank Almeida still off duty sick, pump attended every two hours.

Lat 33.10 N Long 74.17 W.

Tuesday May 23 Came in with strong wind from the North, and squalls, with rough sea on Vessel under two try sails and jib, standing to the Windward on Port tack, Frank Almeida feel better, pump attended every two hours. No observation sun require
