May 24 Came in with strong N East Wind in morning, Schooner under short sails standing to the Windward on Starboard tack, at 2. in afternoon wind ^{was} moderate, we set main sails fore sails and Flying jib, steering N by W, Second Mate put better, pumps attended to
 Lat 35:03 N Long 13:40 W

Thursday

May 25 Came in with light wind from the South East, and clear Weather, Schooner under all sail set, steering N by West, at 10 AM we crossed the Gulf Stream at 3 o'clock in afternoon we lay to on Port tack, at 3:20 we sighted 3 Whaling Schooners two of them was boiling at sun set, we shorting sails, pumps attended to
 Lat 36:39 N Long 13:45 W

Friday

May 26 Came in with fresh breeze from the N East and squalls in afternoon vessel under short sails standing to the Windward on Port tack, we spoke to "Golden City" she had hundred Barrel oil at sun set we took in fore sail and Flying jib, and set fore try sail, Second Mate put better, pumps attended to
 Lat 36:43 N Long 13:49 W

Saturday

May 27 Came in with calm all day and thick fog heavy swell from the East vessel under two try sails and jib, heading S by E, pumps attended to, Golden City in sight,
 No observation, Sun's Obscure

Sunday

May 28 Came in with very light Wind from East, and thick fog, vessel under two try sails and jib, standing to the Windward on Port tack at 1 o'clock P.M. Weather clear up, we set fore sail and Flying jib, saw a school of Porpoises, at sun set took in fore sail set fore try sail, Lat 36:31 N Long 14:11 W

Second Mate put better.

Monday

May 29 Came in with calm and thick fog. All day vessel under two try sails and fore staysails, this day we brookout Haul, and fix the Anchor stock, No observation Sun's Obscure.

Tuesday

May 30 Came in with fresh breeze from the S West, and clear Weather, in morning we killed 2 young Bow Whales going to the Windward quick, we did not lower the Boat, at 11 o'clock No Whales in sight at 1 P.M. we saw a Bark "Bertha" with Boats down chasing Whales, at sun set shorting sails, pumps attended to
 Lat 36:41 N Long 13:28 W

Wednesday

May 31 First part of this day came in with fresh breeze from the North East and squalls with rough sea vessel under short sails standing to the Windward on Port tack, saw a Fair master Schooner bound to North, and scho. Elena Smeeth in sight Boiling at 6 P.M. we were round on Starboard tack, pumps attended to
 Lat 37:04 N Long 13:39 W

Thursday

June 1 First part of this day came in with strong breeze from the North East and squalls with rough sea, on vessel under two try sails and jib standing to the Windward, on Starboard tack at sun set more moderate wind, ship heading N.W. pumps carefully attended every two hours.
 Lat 37:04 N Long 14:00 W

Friday

June 2 First part of this day comes in with light breeze from the South West and very clear Weather vessel under all sail set steering S by E on Starboard tack this day we brookout Reef and supply the crew with Soap Chest, gave lot of porpoises we caught four at sun set shorting sails, Lat 36:53 N Long 14:06 W
