Saturday June 3 First part of this day comes in with strong breeze from the North West and rough sea on. Vessel under short sails standing to the Windward on Starboard tack at 9 A.M. were round on Port tack. Saw a Merchant Fair Mast Schooner tacking up to the Windward, pump attended to.
Leatt 36.57 - Leong 74.07 W.

Sunday June 4 First of this day comes in with light wind from the West and clear weather in morning we set all sails, running off to the Eastward. Four Whales in sight, the "Wm. Grozier" Raised School of Small Whales, she caught one, we did not lower the Boat nor to far off at sun set we shorting sails, standing to the North West, pump attended to.
Leatt 36.39 Leong 73.55 W.

Monday June 5 First part of this day comes in with strong South West Wind, and foggy weather with rough sea on, at 6 o'clock in morning we raise a small alone whale, going to the Windward, we did not lower the Boat nor to far, at 1 o'clock A.M. he went out sight, vessel under Foresail, trysail and jib heading South South East on Starboard tack, the "Golden City" in sight. Saw a Steamer bound to North at Sun set were round, lying on Port tack pump carefully attended to.
Leatt 36.48 Leong 74.06 W.

Tuesday June 6 First part of this day begin with strong breeze from the South West and foggy weather. Vessel under two try sail and jib, standing on Windward on Starboard tack. We spoke to E. B. Council, she has 150 Barrel, at sun set were round on Port tack, pump attended to.

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Wednesday June 7 First part of this day begin with light breeze from the South West. Vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack, heading S. East better part with variable winds and heavy swell from the South, with foggy weather, we took in main sail, and fore sail, set fore and main trysails. Saw a three mast schooner bound to the North West two Whaling Schooners in sight, pump attended to.
Leatt 36.43 Leong 74.30 W.

Thursday June 8 First part of this day begin with very strong wind from the North East, and clear weather. Vessel under two try sails and fore stay sails standing to the Windward on Port tack, at noon were round on Starboard tack standing on Windward, we set the Boats on up crane, we make new Pendant for jib, two Whalers in sight, pump attended to every two hours.
Leatt 36.58 Leong 74.20 W.

Friday June 9 First part of this day comes in with strong West Wind and clear weather, vessel under two try sails and fore stay sail standing to the Windward on Starboard tack, at noon more moderate wind we set fore sails and Flying jib, were round on Port tack - at 5 o'clock P.M. we saw the "Golden City" with two Boat down chasing Whales, we kept off to her, the Whales going to quick we did not lower the Boats, at 7 P.M. we took in Foresail set fore try sails, pump attended to.
Leatt 36.32 Leong 74.17 W.

Saturday June 10 First part of this day begin with light North West Wind, and clear weather, in morning we set main sail, on Port tack, steering N. by East, at 4 o'clock P.M. we luff stern West at Sun set we shorting sails lay in on Port tack, pump attended to.
Leatt 36.47 Leong 73.53 W.
