Sunday June 11 First part of this day came in with good breeze from the South West and clear weather. Vessel under all sails set steering E. East, at 2.30 P.M. we raised a school of small Whales going to the Windward, we lower two Boats, S.B. and one the rest went outright, at 5. P.M. we take the Whale along side, we put gear up, at 6.30 P.M. we commence cut in at 7. finished, and took gear down, shorting sails were ship to the North West lying on Port tack pump attended to
Lat 36.50 Long 73.38

Monday June 12 First of this day came in with strong S. West Wind with rough sea on, Vessel under two try sails, and jib, standing to the Windward on Starboard tack, Boiling at sun set we took in jib were round on Port tack at 8. P.M. finished Boiling, three Whales in sight pump carefully attended
Lat 37.03 Long 73.39 W.

Tuesday June 13 First part of this day comes in with strong S. West wind, and rough sea on Vessel under two try sails and jib, standing to the Windward on Starboard tack, we tore down the oil, and stow off the hole all ready for next day, in afternoon more moderate wind, the crew employed set up the head gear at 7. P.M. were round on Port tack, pump attended to
No observation sun, obscure.

Wednesday June 14 First part of this day comes in with light S. East Wind, and clear & rather Vessel under all sails set crossing. we gave to E. Swift, saw a Black Fish at sun set we shorting sails, pump attended to
Lat 37.05 Long 74.04 W.

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Thursday June 15 First part of this day began with light breeze from the South East and clear weather, Vessel under all sail set crossing, latter part with very light breeze, and calm, with rain we took in main sail, and Flying jib set main try sails, "E. Swift" in sight, and "Golden City," saw a Star Steamer bound S. West, at sun set we took in fore sail set fore try sail
Pump attended to, Lat 36.55 Long 74.20

Friday June 16 First part of this day came in with light S. East Wind and clear weather Vessel under all sails set on Port tack, being up to the Windward, in afternoon began to rain and calm we took in main sails and Flying jib, were round on Starboard tack, two Whales in sight, at sun down took in fore sail set fore try sail, lay on Port tack, pump attended to
Lat 36.48 Long 74.15

Saturday June 17 First part of this day came in with very light wind from the South East and heavy swell, Vessel under all sails set, crossing, we brookout Barrel Flour in afternoon, we spoke to W. Grozier, at sun set we shorting sails lay on Starboard tack, pump attended to.
Lat 36.55 Long 74.13 W.

Sunday June 18 First part of this day began with light breeze and calm, Vessel under all sails set steering S. East on Starboard tack in company with "W. Grozier." at sun set were ship on Port tack, and shorting sails - pump attended to
Lat 37.03 Long 74.70
